

Remarks on board Bark Geoman Cruising for

Friday Oct 17th 1845 commences light winds and fine pleasant weather steering course S.W. wind from the N.E. - saw finback middle part the same latter part saw bowfish and finbacks so ends this day Lat 9° 19' N

Saturday Oct 18th 1845 comes in with calms and fine clear weather saw Green porpoises at sundown set quarter watches middle part light winds from the N.E. latter part the same saw porpoises set up the main rope yard so ends this day Lat 8° 25' N

Sunday Oct 19th 1845 This day comes in with moderate breezes from the N.E. steering W. employed in repairing sails middle part rainy latter part the same so ends this day Lat 7° 57' N Long 23° 12' W

Monday Oct 20th 1845 This day comes in with calms and cloudy saw nothing worth remarking middle part rainy latter part the same had light winds from the N.E. steering W. so ends this day Lat 7° 40' N Long

Tuesday Oct 21st 1845 comes in with light winds and warm steering to the westward saw porpoises middle part fine latter part saw two sail steering to the eastward one showed French colors so ends this day Lat 7° 36' N Long 23° 45' W

Wednesday Oct 22nd 1845 commences moderate breezes from the N.W. saw nothing worth remarking at sundown started saw middle part the same latter part wind from E.S.E. steering N.W. so ends this day Lat 7° 20' N Long 24° 20' W

Thursday Oct 23rd 1845 comes in with moderate breezes and squally wind from the E.S.E. steering N.W. and rainy middle part the same latter part light wind from E.S.E. steering N.W. saw diamond fish so ends this day Lat 7° 30' N

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Friday Oct 24th 1845 This day comes in with light winds and variable steering westerly had several showers of rain middle part fine latter part saw three Brigs steering N.E. wind from S.W. so ends this day Lat 6° 48' N Long 25° 48' W

Saturday Oct 25th 1845 commences with moderate breezes from the S.W. heading S.E. at 4 P.M. tacked ship to the N.W. by middle part the same latter part at 6 P.M. tacked ship to the S.W. wind from S. so ends this day Lat 6° 22' N

Sunday Oct 26th 1845 This day comes in with moderate breezes from the S.W. heading by the wind N. S.W. at 4 P.M. wind hauled to the N.W. steering course S by N. wind revving middle part the same latter part wind from S.W. heading by the wind S.E. saw one sail steering on a north S.E. so ends this day Lat 5° 24' N

Monday Oct 27th 1845 This day commences with fresh breezes from the S.W. heading by the wind S.E. middle part the same latter part wind from the S.E. heading E.S.E. saw one bark steering E. westerly so ends this day Lat 4° 50' N Long 21° 38' W

Tuesday Oct 28th 1845 First part of this day comes in with moderate breezes from the S heading S.E. saw finbacks middle part the same latter part saw nothing so ends this day Lat 4° 11' N

Wednesday Oct 29th 1845 This day comes in with moderate breezes from the S.W. heading by the wind S.E. by E. saw one bark steering by the wind S.E. westerly at 6 P.M. we tacked to N.W. middle part the same latter part employed in setting up the fore rigging saw two sail steering westerly Lat 3° 45' N Long 20° 40' W

Thursday Oct 30th 1845 This day commences with moderate breezes from the S heading S.W. by N.W. saw nothing worth remarking middle part squally latter part heading S.W. wind from S.E. saw one sail steering S.W. so ends this day Lat 2° 49' N
