Thursday Feb 12 comes in with moderate breezes from the S.W. heading N spoke Ship Barker 19 months out 2 1/2 months out clear had spoken Cachalot 3 days before 7.00 9 months out middle part cabin latter part the same at daylight took in starboard boat to repair so ends this day Lat 37° 49' S Long 45° 55' W

Friday Feb 13th comes in with calms saw Green and albacore 4 P.M. light wind from S steering S under shortened sail middle part fine latter part squally heading S E so ends this day saw beaches



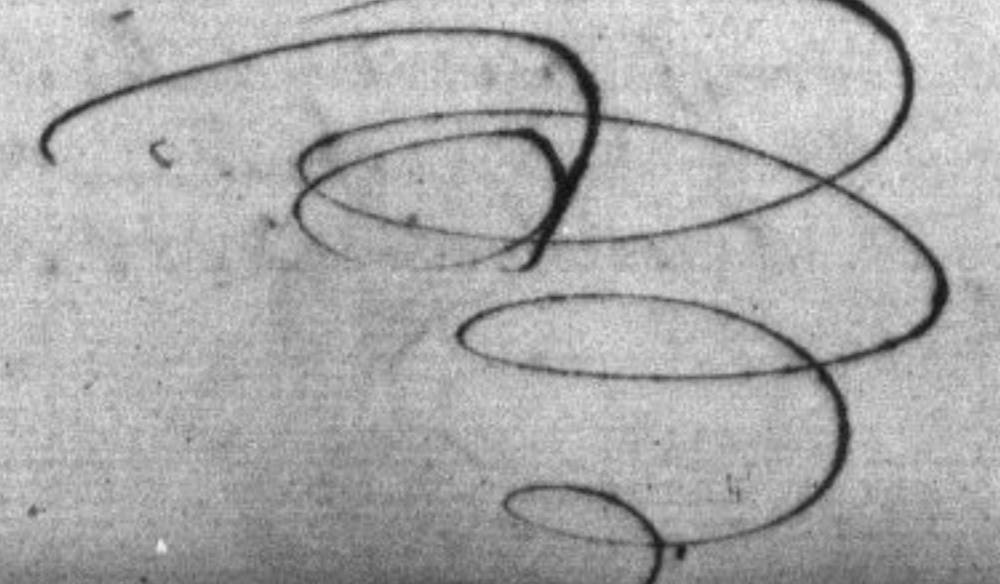
Saturday Feb 14th commences moderate breezes from the S heading S E at 5 P.M. spoke Bark Elizabeth 19 months out 7.00 middle strong breezes latter part the same under double reefed topsails at 10.00 saw bark to windward supposed her to be the Sarah of Seattle so ends this day Lat 39° 13' S Long

Sunday Feb 15th commences moderate gales at 2 P.M. took in courses with fore topsail at 4 P.M. close reefed the main middle part the same latter part more moderate saw several ships coming from the S.W. so ends this day Lat 39° 35' S Long 47° 15' W



Monday Feb 16th comes in with moderate breezes and pleasant weather wind N heading 10 P.M. spoke Ship Canton 39 months out 8.00 lb sperm and 19 lb oil bound home sent letters home middle part moderate gales latter part the same heading N W so ends this day Lat 38° 25' S Long 47° 11' W

Tuesday Feb 17th comes in with moderate gales from heading N W at 4 P.M. more moderate at 8 P.M. middle part same latter part at 9 P.M. took in main sail and foresail and set spruce so ends this day Lat 37° 20' S Long 48° 56' W



Wednesday Feb 18th comes in with moderate gales from the S heading S W at 11 P.M. at 2 P.M. got foresail at 6 P.M. more moderate latter part the same wind from the S heading S W at 8 P.M. packed ship to the S so ends this day Lat 37° 43' S Long 45° 30' W

Thursday Feb 19th comes in with strong breezes from S E heading S at 5 P.M. packed ship to the S W and set 4 lb spruce and took one reef out of the top sails middle fine latter part the same saw Green and see and Killers all hands employed in cooping salt provisions so ends this day Lat 38° 18' S Long 45° 45' W

Friday Feb 20th comes in with moderate breezes from the S E heading S saw Killers all hands employed in cooping and stowing away middle part calm latter part at 7 P.M. spoke Bark Catherwood of Westport 4 months out clear so ends this day Lat 38° 57' S Long 45° 20' W

Saturday Feb 21st commences moderate winds from N E steering course S E in company with the Catherwood saw one bark to leeward at 7 P.M. spoke Bark Le Baron New Port 16 months out 185 lb sperm latter part strong breezes so ends this day Lat 39° 50' S Long 49° 28' W

Sunday Feb 22d commences moderate breezes from the N heading E at 8 saw several vessels at 4 P.M. spoke Bark Le Baron let them have some cigars middle fine latter part strong breezes from the N heading by the wind at 10 P.M. at 10 P.M. got a former lot of ends this day Lat 39° 24' S Long 50° 10' W Long Lane 51° 11' W

Monday Feb 23d commences moderate breezes from the N heading N W at 11 saw nothing worthy remark at 2 P.M. packed ship to the S W middle part fine latter part squally and raining under short sail saw the Bark Le Baron so ends this day Lat
