

Remarks on board Bark Yeoman Whaling

1846 Saturday May 23^d comes in with fine pleasant weather and variable employed in sail making middle part some from the S steering course or had much thunder and lightning from the SW and plenty of rain latter part the same so ends this day 8th Chs

Sunday May 24th comes in with moderate breezes from the S steering course or at 1/2 at 7 P.M. took in top sails had much thunder and lightning accompanied with squalls of rain middle part at 9 P.M. hauled aboard the main top sail and took in top gallant sails latter part at daylight made the fall of ground bearing N distance about 16 miles and very light coming steering in towards the harbor latter part at daylight account at 3 P.M. came to anchor in 15 fathoms of water so ends this day Sunday May 26th comes in with rain all hands employed in repairing and cleaning ship latter part fine middle the same Wednesday May 27th comes in with fine pleasant weather got off two boat loads of wood and one raft of water middle part fine Thursday May 28th comes in with fine pleasant weather got off two boat loads of wood and two rafts of water latter fine Friday May 29th comes in with fine pleasant weather got off two rafts of wood and two of water and stowed off the hole Saturday May 30th comes in with fine pleasant weather got off two boat loads of wood at 2 P.M. got under weigh and stood over towards the city of London at 7 o'clock on a reef of rocks but got off without much trouble at 8 o'clock the anchor down in about 6 fathoms of water plied up the sails and let the lay for the night at daylight got under weigh and stood over towards the city at the foreboard watch go ashore on liberty the 31st and last of the month at sundown returned again Monday June comes in with fine pleasant weather foreboard watch went ashore on liberty and the other watch employed in painting foreboard watch went ashore on liberty at sundown returned again the Liberty men

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Wednesday June 3^d comes in with fine pleasant weather foreboard watch went ashore on liberty the other watch breaking out for flour Thursday June 4th comes in with fine pleasant weather at 10 o'clock got under weigh for sea with one passenger on board at 6 P.M. came to anchor for the night Friday June 5th comes in with strong breezes from the SW steering course I saw one steamer steaming in towards Rio de Janeiro this day Sea Account 55 55 55 55 55

Saturday June 6th Sea account comes in with strong breezes from the SW steering course at 5 P.M. the Sagar Loaf off Rio de Janeiro distance about 15 miles middle part at 9 o'clock saw Cape Rio light bearing 10 distance 10 miles latter part moderate employed in fitting boats for whaling so ends this day Latt 22 26 S Long 40 10 W

Sunday June 7th comes in with fine pleasant weather from the SW steering course or 1/2 at 2 P.M. set fore topmast standing sail saw several Finbacks middle part fine latter part the same saw Bark steering N in company with us so ends this day Latt 20 40 S Long 38 50 W

Monday June 8th comes in with fine pleasant weather steering course N wind 8 W set lower studding sail middle part fine latter part the same at 9 o'clock saw several Finbacks so ends this day employed in painting and sail making Latt 18 45 S Long 37 50 W

Tuesday June 9th comes in with fine pleasant weather steering course N 1/2 W wind from the SW middle part the same latter part at 8 o'clock saw several large breachers supposed them to be Finbacks so ends this day employed in sail making Latt 16 54 S Long 36 20 W

Wednesday June 10th comes in with fine pleasant weather wind from SW steering course N 1/2 W saw nothing worth remarking middle part fine latter part wind from N 1/2 W bearing N 1/2 W and very light with several squalls of rain at 10 o'clock saw main topmast standing sail so ends this day Latt 15 15 S Long 35 57 W
