

Remarks on board Bark Geomun Sperm Whaling

1846 Thursday June 10th comes in with fine pleasant weather
employed in turning in the fore rigging afresh and
sail making wind from the E heading at 10⁰⁰ saw not
worth remarking middle part wind from the E heading
at 10⁰⁰ E latter part wind from W W lashed ship
to N E & so ends this day Lat 41° 17' S Long

Friday June 12th comes in with fine pleasant weather
wind from S W steering course N E saw two sail steering
to Northward middle part wind from the S latter the same
saw one sail steering to S W so ends employed in
sail making and ship duty Lat 12° 58' S

Saturday June 13th comes in with fine pleasant weather
had several showers of rain wind from S steering course N E
saw Junipers middle part the same latter part wind from
S E steering course N E saw nothing worth remarking so
ends this day employed in sail making Lat 10° 56' S Long

Sunday June 14th comes in with fine pleasant weather steering
course N E wind S E had several light showers of rain middle
part wind from S latter part the same at 8⁰⁰ A M passed
an English steamer steering S W towards Rio so ends this
day Lat 8° 23' S Long

Monday June 15th comes in with strong trade winds from
S E steering course N E by 10⁰⁰ saw nothing worth remarking
middle part wind from S E took in Top Mast stay
and left Top sail and S D Jellum sail
and latter part wind S E under all sail so ends
this day Lat at 10 o'clock 5° 40' S Long 36° 45' W

Tuesday June 16th comes in with strong trade winds from
S E steering course N E by 10⁰⁰ saw several vessels steering S
middle part fine latter part the same saw four ships
at 9 A M got a Lunar Observation made Long 36° 36' W Lat 5° 00' S

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Wednesday June 17th comes in with strong trade winds
from S E steering course N E saw nothing worth remarking
middle part fine latter part at 9 A M saw shoal of
blue fish lowered the boats for them but without
success so ends this day Lat 10° 16' S Long

Thursday June 18th comes in with moderate trades from
the S E steering course N E saw nothing worth remarking
middle part moderate latter part the same employed in
sail making so ends this day Lat 1° 56' N Long 36° 10' W

Friday June 19th comes in with moderate trades from S
steering course N E employed in sail making middle
part fine latter part the same nothing employed in sail
making so ends this day Lat 3° 56' N Long 30° 10' W

Saturday June 20th comes in with moderate trades from
S E steering course N E at 10⁰⁰ A M had a new main Top Sail made
part the same latter part wind hauled to the N E
and rain so ends this day Lat 5° 42' N Long

Sunday June 21st comes in with light winds from
the S E steering course N E middle part very moderate
latter part the same had wind from all quarters
of the compass so ends this day saw nothing worth
remarking Lat 6° 46' N Long 30° 10' W

Monday June 22nd comes in with moderate breezes
and variable winds steering to Northward middle part
rainy latter part fine sails hoisted at 9 A M calm
so ends this day Lat 7° 42' S Long 30° 05' W

Tuesday June 23rd comes in with moderate breezes from
the E steering to Northward had several showers
of rain middle part drizzling wind from E steering course N E
latter part wind N E steering by the wind so ends
this day Lat 8° 00' N
