

Remarks on board Bark Geomem. Spinn Whaling

1846 Wednesday June 24th comes in with strong trades from  
 N<sup>W</sup> by heading N<sup>W</sup> by N saw nothing worth remarking  
 at 11 P.M. took in T<sup>h</sup> Gib Middle the same latter  
 part more moderate set Blyin Gib again so ends  
 this day Lat 9° 36' N Long 57° 20' W

Thursday June 25th comes in with strong trades from  
 N<sup>W</sup> by heading N<sup>W</sup> by N saw nothing Middle part  
 veerights and rainy latter part the same took in  
 Blyin Gib and main T<sup>h</sup> Gib studding sail so ends  
 this day Lat 10° 05'

Friday June 26th comes in with strong breezes from  
 N<sup>W</sup> heading N<sup>W</sup> under all sail Middle part  
 at 11 P.M. took in topmast studding sail and gaff T<sup>h</sup>  
 latter part more moderate set them again so ends this  
 day employed in ships duty Lat 13° 17' W

Saturday June 27th comes in with strong trades from  
 E S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> saw nothing worth remarking  
 Middle part the same latter part moderate under  
 sail steering N<sup>W</sup> to so ends this day Lat 15° 51' S Long 36° 44'

Sunday June 28th comes in with moderate breezes from  
 the E S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> by N Middle part strong breeze  
 from the N<sup>W</sup> heading N<sup>W</sup> took in Blyin Gib  
 gaff T<sup>h</sup> sail latter part the same so ends this day  
 employed in ships duty Lat 18° 09' N Long 38° 10' W

Monday June 29th comes in with strong trade winds  
 from the E S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> by N Middle part  
 the same latter part saw bark steering to N<sup>W</sup> toward  
 so ends this day but another foretop gallant sail and repaid  
 the other Lat 20° 07' N Long 40° 40' W

Tuesday June 30th comes in with strong trade winds from  
 E S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> at 10 took out the hatchway for  
 beams and butter Middle part squally latter part the  
 same saw great quantities of gulph weed so ends  
 Lat 23° 18' N Long 42° 30' W

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1846 Wednesday July 1st comes in with strong trade winds from  
 E steering N<sup>W</sup> and squally Middle part the same  
 latter part moderate steering N<sup>W</sup> from E S<sup>W</sup> ends  
 this day employed in ships duty Lat 26° 10' N Long

Thursday July 2nd comes in with moderate trade winds from  
 the E S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> Middle part very moderate wind  
 from E S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> latter part the same  
 so ends this day employed in ships duty Lat 27° 45' N

Friday July 3rd comes in with light winds from S<sup>W</sup> steering  
 N<sup>W</sup> saw several dolphins caught here Middle part calm had light  
 shower of rain latter part light wind from S<sup>W</sup> steering  
 N<sup>W</sup> saw nothing worth remarking Lat 27° 59' N

Saturday July 4th comes in with light winds and variable  
 steering at 10 saw a shovel nose shark Middle part wind S<sup>W</sup>  
 set top mast studding sail latter part under all sail  
 saw Grampuses so ends this day Lat 28° 34' N

Sunday July 5th comes in with moderate winds from  
 S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> saw nothing worth remarking  
 Middle part Middle part the same latter part  
 wind S steering N<sup>W</sup> saw Grampuses so ends  
 this day Lat 30° 34' N Long 45° 08' W

Monday July 6th comes in with moderate breezes from  
 the S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> saw nothing worth remarking  
 Middle part wind N latter part the same at 7 P.M.  
 saw shoal of Black fish followed for them but without  
 success so ends this day Lat 32° 15' N Long 46° 15' W

Tuesday July 7th comes in with moderate breezes from  
 S<sup>W</sup> steering N<sup>W</sup> at 3 P.M. hauled to the yonder  
 S<sup>W</sup> N<sup>W</sup> saw nothing worth remarking Middle part  
 fine latter part the same Lat 33° 05' N Long 47° 42' W
