

Remarks on Board Bark German Sperm Whaling

1846 Saturday August 15 comes in with light winds from
 W heading W S W saw nothing worth remarking
 middle part fine latter part saw porpoises and one sail
 steering NW so ends this day Latt 40° 08'



Sunday August 16th comes in with moderate breezes from
 S W steering course over W saw several spoils long distance
 off middle part fine latter part saw porpoises and
 one small turtle so ends this day



Monday August 17th comes in with moderate breezes
 from the W heading NW W middle part squally and rain
 latter part saw two sail and several school of grampuses
 wind from W S W heading S so ends this day Latt 40° 18'

Tuesday August 18th comes in with moderate breezes from
 W S W heading by the wind I saw two sail steering to the
 eastward middle part mainly latter part at daylight saw
 Blackfish toward the boats and took three of them so
 ends this day



Wednesday August 19th comes in with fine pleasant weather
 heading W S W wind from NW saw grampuses middle
 part fine latter part the same saw two sail steering
 to NE and saw one sword fish so ends Latt 38° 40'

Thursday August 20 First part of this day comes in with light
 winds from the NW heading W S W saw grampuses middle
 part squally latter part the same at daylight commenced
 raining and the Blackfish at 11 & 12 finished had several
 showers of rain so ends this day Latt

Friday August 21st First part of this day comes in with
 squally weather wind from W S W heading NW saw
 one sail steering NE middle part variable winds and
 rain latter part the same saw several breaches of seal
 but saw no more of them so ends this day

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Saturday August 22nd comes in with moderate breezes from
 Westward heading by the wind saw two fish middle part
 wind from the Eastward steering W latter part the same
 saw several sail so ends this day Latt 38° 39' Long 34° 56'

Sunday August 23rd comes in with moderate breezes and
 fine pleasant weather steering course W wind E saw a
 number of vessels steering on a wind middle part the same
 latter part wind hauled to the N extended saw several
 sail steering to NE so ends this day

Monday August 24th comes in with moderate breezes
 from the W heading by the wind at 6 P M spoke Bark
 Rollo of New York from Charleston bound to Genoa
 middle part fine latter part squally saw great many
 vessels bound to the NE so ends this day

Tuesday August 25 comes in with strong breezes and
 squally wind from the S W steering course NW at
 6 P M spoke Ship Enspirated of Bedford 18 days
 from N Bedford 6000 of Sperm got some letters from her
 to send home so ends this day Latt 38° 33'

Wednesday August 26 comes in with strong breezes from the
 NW heading W S W caught a porpoise middle part fine
 north moderate breezes latter part the same wind from the
 E NE steering course NE at 9 A M got 3 Top Mast Standing
 sail so ends this day Latt 37° 59'

Thursday August 27th comes in with strong breezes and
 squally wind from the E steering W at 6 P M took in
 spinnaker and main sail and gave Top Mast Standing
 had much rain middle part fine latter part the same
 so ends this day Latt

Friday August 28th comes in with strong breezes from the
 E steering W saw nothing worth remarking middle part
 the same latter part moderate saw grampuses so ends this day
 under call 8 sail Latt 38° 51' Long 33° 30'
