Friday January 22nd 1847

Begins with a light breeze from S.E. steering S.W. under all sail middle and latter part the same breeze all hands busy employed at work so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 50 m
Long by Chr

Saturday January 23rd 1847

Begins with light breeze from S.E. heading S.W. under all sail middle part the same without change of sail and latter part a strong breeze from S.W. steering S.W. under all sail so ends then 24 hours Lat by obs 2° 26' Long 27° 50'

Sunday January 24th 1847

Begins with light breeze from S.E. heading S.W. under all sail at work on main top side middle part the same latter part a strong breeze at 4 am steering S.W. by S so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 30° 08' S
Long by Chr 28° 45'

Monday January 25th 1847

Begins with a strong breeze from S.E. steering S.W. by S under all sail middle part the same latter part to work on the top so nothing of the whale kind so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 6° 08' S
Long by Chr 30° 50'

Tuesday January 26th 1847

Begins with a strong breeze from S.E. heading S.W. by S under all sail middle and latter part the same at 10 p.m. heading S.W. under all sail latter part the same so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 8° 13' S
Long by Chr 32° 58'

On a Whaling Voyage. Board off the ship in Plate

Wednesday January 27th 1847

Begins with good weather the wind from S.E. steering S.W. under all sail middle part the same latter part squally at good lookout kept but nothing seen so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 12° 21' S
Long by Chr 32° 49' W

Thursday January 28th 1847

Begins with a good breeze from S.E. heading S.W. under all sail middle part the same latter part the same so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 12° 30' S
Long by Chr 34° 00' W

Friday January 29th 1847

Begins with good weather with S.E. breeze heading S.W. under all sail at 10 am a strong breeze kept for whales expecting to see some soon middle and latter part the same so ends then 24 hours Lat 15° 00' S
Long 35° 30'

Saturday January 30th 1847

Begins with pleasant weather the wind from S.E. steering S.W. under all sail middle and latter part the same with nothing of the whale kind so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 18° 38' S
Long by Chr 36° 00'

Sunday January 31st 1847

Begins with a good breeze from N.E. heading S.W. under all sail at sunset took in sail and heaved to the wind heading S.E. under all sail middle part the same at daylight kept off S.W. under all sail latter part a good breeze so ends then 24 hours
Lat by obs 17° 38' S
Long by Chr 35° 45'
