Begins with a Strong Breeze from N.E. heading Southward. Under all sail. Under fore topgallant sail and Rest in the fore. At midday the part the same. Saw Grampuses at 10 miles. So ended the 24 hours. Lat by obs 29.28 Long by Chron 43.13

Saturday February 13th 1847

Begins with a Light Breeze from S.E. heading S.E. by E. Under all sail. Under fore topgallant sail and Rest in the fore. At midday the part the same. Light air and calm. Saw Lots of Grampuses. So ended the 24 hours. Lat by obs 29.24 Long 43.48

Sunday February 14th 1847

Begins with Light air and calm. Saw Grampuses and Porpoises. Under all sail. Under fore topgallant sail and Rest in the fore. At midday the part the same. Light air and calm. Saw none. So ended the 24 hours. Lat by obs 30.28

Monday February 15th 1847

Begins with a Good Breeze from S.E. heading S.W. Under all sail. At 8 am took in fore and main topgallant sail. Lat by obs 31.10 Long by Chron 46.01

Tuesday February 16th 1847

Begins with a Gale from S.E. Under all sail. Under fore topgallant sail. At 10 am took in fore and main topgallant sail. Lat by obs 31.20 Long by Chron 46.02

Wednesday February 17th 1847

Begins with a Strong Breeze from S.E. heading S.W. Under all sail. Under fore topgallant sail and Rest in the fore. At midday the part the same. Light air and calm. Saw one Spermfish. So ended the 24 hours. Lat by obs 32.00 Long by Chron 47.08

Thursday February 18th 1847

Begins with a Good Breeze from the Northward. Steering S.W. Under all sail. Under fore topgallant sail and Rest in the fore. At 8 am took in fore topgallant sail. Under all sail. Under fore topgallant sail and Rest in the fore. At midday the part the same. Good weather. Saw Grampuses and other white water. So ended the 24 hours. Lat by obs 32.27 S. Long by Chron 48.56 W.
