

Remarks Made on Board Ship Geomani

Saturday April 24th 1847

Begins with Rainy weather Fixing Sprads on the poles and dolt and Latta part the same Sun one piece of Sprad So ends there 24 hours

Sunday April 25th 1847

Begins with a strong breeze from the Northward heading to the Eastward under topsail middle part more moderate Latta part Blowy So ends there 24 hours

Monday April 26th 1847

Begins with a Light breeze from the westward heading to the Southward and Eastward under topsail middle and Latta part the same So ends there 24 hours

Tuesday April 27th 1847

Begins with a Light breeze from the westward under topsail middle and Latta part the same Sun Nothing of any consequence all hands Business as usual So ends there 24 hours Lat by obs 34.40

Wednesday April 28th 1847

Begins with Light wind from the Southward heading to the Eastward under topsail middle part the same at 8 o'clock commenced Reprising topsail Latta part the same So ends there 24 hours

Continuing off the River La Plata for whales

Thursday April 29th 1847

Begins with Light breeze and Calms trying to get to the Southward and Eastward, Reprising topsail middle and Latta part the same. So ends there 24 hours Lat by obs 35.15 Long by Chron 67.02

Friday April 30th 1847

Begins with Light breeze and Calms, with a strong current setting to Northward middle and Latta part the same breeze, So ends there 24 hours Lat by obs 35.32 Long by Chron

Saturday May 1st 1847

Begins with Light breeze from the Southward heading to the Northward and Eastward still Reprising topsail middle and Latta part the same So ends there 24 hours

Sunday May 2nd 1847

Begins with a Light breeze from the Northward middle part the same. At 4 o'clock saw whales, blowing strong Latta part steering the same So ends there 24 hours



Monday May 3rd 1847

Begins with a strong breeze and whales in sight at 13 p.m. Latta part Boat and then to a whale, then we hauled one after Boat we killed the whale we made to haul him Long Side, and we started from him middle part a tale of wind at 4 m found our whale took him Long Side and commenced cutting to
