

Remarks Made on Second Bark Journey

Tuesday May 4th 1847

Begins with strong breeze. Still a cutting in our whale
middle and latter part good weather. At 9 am got
the body in, lost the head, commenced boiling. So
ends there 24 hours. Lat 20.19

Wednesday May 5th 1847

Begins with good weather. Boiling our whale
middle part. A strong breeze from Northward. Latter part
the same. So ends there 24 hours. Lat by obs

Thursday May 6th 1847

Begins with a strong breeze. Still a boiling middle
part the same. At 4 pm got the body in. Latter
part part of a bale from N.E. So ends there 24 hours.

Friday May 7th 1847

Begins with a strong breeze. Still blowing hard
middle and latter part the same. So ends there 24 hours.
Lat by obs

Saturday May 8th 1847

Begins with a strong breeze from the N.W. middle
part the same. At 9 am commenced throwing down
latter part the same. So ends there 24 hours. Lat

Cruising of the River La Plata for Whales

Sunday May 9th 1847

Begins with a light breeze from the westward. Stowed down
9 bbls of sperm oil. middle and latter part the same.
At 9 am got all stowed away and washed off to look after

Monday May 10th 1847

Begins with a light breeze from the westward. Saw four hawks
two of them, middle and latter part the same. So ends there
24 hours. Lat

Tuesday May 11th 1847

Begins with light wind from the southward. Saw one
hawk middle and latter part the same. So ends there
24 hours. Lat 30.20

Wednesday May 12th 1847

Begins with good weather and wind from the westward. Saw
one hawk middle part the same. Latter part a strong breeze
from N.W. Steering North under reef top sail, saw several
hundreds of porpoises. So ends there 24 hours.
Lat by obs 30.19
Long by obs 40.00

Thursday May 13th 1847

Begins with good weather. Steering to the northward under
Red top sail. Bore to the island of Grand for wood and
water middle and latter part the same. So ends there
24 hours. Lat by obs 33.20. P.
