

Remarks Made on Board Bark Teoman

Friday May 14th 1867

Begins with a Strong Breeze from the westward heading Steering N. by W. under Reef topsails middle part tacked Reefs out. Latter part had topgallant sails on her Brought her fore sail to end there 24 hours Lat 23.20 S.

Saturday May 15th 1867

Begins with Good weather the wind from S. by E. heading N. by E. under All sail middle and Latter part the same. All hands busily employed at 12 A.M. saw fin backs to each there 24 hours Lat by obs 31.13 S. Longitude 110

Sunday May 16th 1867

Begins with Good weather Steering N. by W. under All sail middle and Latter part the same the wind from S. by E. heading N. by E. to end there 24 hours Lat 28.40

Monday May 17th 1867

Begins with Good weather wind from S. by E. heading N. by E. under All sail middle part Strong Breeze At 10 A.M. Tacked to Eastward Latter part Strong Breeze to end there 24 hours Lat 28.20

Tuesday May 18th 1867

Begins with a Strong Breeze from the Northward heading to the Eastward under All sail Reef topsails middle and Latter part fine weather the wind from the Southward heading N. by E. under all sail Lays rigging to end there 24 hours Lat by obs 27.18 S.

Bound to Rio Grande for Wood and Water

Wednesday May 19th 1867

Begins with a Light Breeze from the Southward heading N. by E. middle part Calm. All hand getting rigging Latter part Light Breeze from S. by E. heading N. by E. to end there 24 hours. Lat. 1.40 S. Long 28.19 Longitude 115.20

Thursday May 20th 1867

Begins with a Good Breeze from E. by S. Steering N. by W. under All sail middle and Latter part the same in Green water to end there 24 hours Lat by obs 24.00 Long 46.10

Friday May 21st 1867

Begins with a Strong Breeze from E. by S. heading N. by W. under All sail. At 2 P.M. Made the Land. At 4 P.M. Tacked off there middle part the same Latter part moderate to end there 24 hours Lat by obs 26.20. Land in sight

Saturday May 22nd 1867

Begins with Light Breeze from E. by S. At 11 P.M. had a Strong Breeze from S. by E. Steering N. by E. under All sail middle part the same Latter part moderate At 11 A.M. saw one humpback heard one but the boat boat there to end there 24 hours Lat 26.45

Sunday May 23rd 1867

Begins with Light Breeze from E. by S. At 10 A.M. took a humpback Long Lidge middle and Latter part Light Breeze heading in there to end there 24 hours Lat by obs 26.10 Longitude 116.40
