

Remarks Made On Board Ship Yeamoy

Thursday October 28th 1847

Begins with a light breeze from S^E steering course S. by E. and
all sail made just the same at 5 P.M. the boat to pass
the crew better just now than yesterday. ^{sat 25.37}
so ends this day

Long 36.42

Friday October 29th

Begins with a strong breeze from S^E steering course S. by E. and
all sail made and the part the more now it makes of the
boats so ends this day ^{sat 23.51}
Long 25.16

Saturday October 30th

Begins with moderate trades winds from S^E steering course
S. by E. and all sail made just the same later part the
S^E steering course it makes as usual on the sails so ends
this day ^{sat 21.44}
Long 29.18

Sunday October 31st

Begins with strong trades winds from S^E steering course S.
under all sail still it sail steering to the S at 5 P.M. on board
the fore and main topgallant sails and boat outboard made just
same at 10 P.M. made up the way and leave the main yard
back at daylight made sail saw ^{sat 20.45} ^{Long 32.30}
at 11 light of S^E by S saw humpback and porpoises so ends
this day

Monday November 1st

Begins with strong trades from S^E steering course S. by E.
under all sail saw humpback made just the same later part the
all hands engaged separating the foremast so ends this day ^{sat 18.18}

Tuesday November 2nd

Begins with a moderate breeze from S^E steering course S.
under all sail made and the part the same all hands
at work on the sail saw nothing worth recording so ends
this day ^{sat 17.14}
Long 33.47

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Wednesday November 3rd 1847

Begins with a strong breeze from S^E steering course S. by E.
under all sail at sunset shortened sail and hauled to the
main making 12 by 6 made just the same set boat, crew, masts
at daylight made sail and kept off S^E by the sun and masts
hauled and for bread and outboard small stores so ends this day
^{sat 16.18}
Long 34.24

Thursday November 4th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S^E steering course S. by E.
under all sail at 4 P.M. on board the foremast and sail at north
at sunset shortened sail made just the same later part the
light made sail at 10 P.M. dulla left the fore topmast
sail the part steering bears so ends this day ^{sat 15.14}
Long 35.12

Friday November 5th

Begins with a strong breeze from S^E steering course S. by E.
under all sail at 1 P.M. last ship heading S^E
at sunset shortened sail at sunset made sail and later same on
daylight made sail later more moderate weather so ends
sail for water so ends this day ^{sat 16.19}
Long 35.10

Saturday November 6th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S^E heading S^E under
all sail topmast at sunset shortened sail made and later part
the same at 4 P.M. last ship heading S^E saw nothing so ends this
day saw a whale steering on to wind to the southward

Sunday November 7th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S^E heading S^E under
all sail made the same later strong breeze saw white water
and greenhouses the wind from S^E so ends this day

Monday November 8th

Begins with moderate trades from S^E heading at under hula topmast
no fishback at sunset shortened sail at daylight shortened sail
saw a sail steering to the southward saw some small white water. It
seems another distance the boats there and and and and and and and
longer it was going to take him to the southward he gave up and
back to back half a hour where he came on deck. I think
he is a member of the crew that he would like to see the
the god home so ends this day
