

Remarks Made On Board Bark Yeoman

Saturday January 1st 1848

Begins with a strong breeze from S by E heading S W by W under all sails smooth at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later at daylight made sail at 7 am took ship to S E 1/4 B. on reef the topsails were forepoysed and whiskered so ends this day

Sunday January 2nd

Begins with a strong breeze from S S W heading S E under reef topsails at sunset were shorted sail at 11 am and shortened sail middle part the same later part at daylight made sail at 7 am took ship to S E 1/4 B. on reef the topsails were forepoysed and whiskered so ends this day

Monday January 3rd

Begins with a moderate breeze from S S E kept off at sunset all sail at sunset shortened sail and went left to the wind at 1/2 middle part the same later part at daylight made sail all hands employed making out for under and beneath deck of vessel at 8 am took ship to S E so ends this day

Tuesday January 4th

Begins with a light breeze from E N E heading S E under all sails at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later part at daylight made sail and took ship heading to the Southward spring a blow signified dark. Lat at 8 am took ship to W by N at 10 am reef the topsails so ends this day

Wednesday January 5th

Begins with a strong breeze from S by W took ship to S E by E at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later part at daylight the wind hauled to S S W kept off at 1/2 at daylight made sail middle part the same later part at daylight made sail and took ship so ends this day

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Thursday January 6th 1848

Begins with a light breeze from S S W steering course at E under all sail saw porpoises at sunset shortened sail and hauled to the wind with our starboard topsails O. hauled middle and later part the same so ends this day

Friday January 7th

Begins with a light breeze from S S E steering on the wind E under all sail at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later at daylight made sail at 7 am took ship to S S W saw grampars and caught two abalone captain making arrangements at 11 am employed fitting blocks strops so ends this day

Long 48, 26

Saturday January 8th

Begins with a light breeze from S S E steering on the wind S S W under all sail saw grampars and caught one at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later part at daylight made sail at 10 am hauled the boats for billes with and masts saw a number schools of grampars and one turtle so ends this day

Lat 35, 44
Long 48, 42

Sunday January 9th

Begins with a light breeze from S E steering on the wind S S W under all sail saw grampars at 9 am the wind hauled to E 1/2 S at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later part at daylight made sail and at 8 am kept off at 1/2 the wind from S saw two Barks steering to the Eastward so ends this day

Long 48, 15

Monday January 10th

Begins with light air and calm from S steering course S under all sail saw grampars and caught at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later part at daylight made sail and took ship steering to the Eastward so ends this day
