

Remarks Made Code Book Book Y

Monday January 11th 1848

Begins with fine pleasant weather the wind of steering course S at 6
Pm left to the wind with one starboard tack about two sails, stea-
ring to the Eastward at sunset shortened sail, middle part. The
course at 12 noon left to Eastward in the full at daylight in
sail at 4 am left off S and 2 sails steering to Eastward
so ends this day Lat 36 33
Long 48 50

Tuesday January 12th

Begins with a light breeze from N at 5 hauld up to 5 W
under all sail saw passengers and squid at sunset shortened
sail at 10 the wind with part the same later part
at daylight made sail at 4 left off S and 2 sails steering to
Ship clearing to the Eastward so ends this day Lat 36 58
Long 46 43

Wednesday January 13th

Begins with a light breeze from N steering course S W under
sail 4 Pm the wind from S S E was 6 sail at sunset shortened
middle part the same later part at daylight made sail the same
from N at 11 am of Day steering to the Northward saw porpo-
ses so ends this day Lat 37 22
Long 47 56

Thursday January 14th

Begins with a light breeze from W at 11 steering course S W
all sail caught one porpoise at sunset shortened sail middle part
the same later part at daylight made sail all hands employed looking
for whales saw one off of sail so ends this day Lat 37 44
Long 47 44

Friday January 15th

Begins with light breeze from W at 11 steering course S W
all sail saw green porpoises at sunset shortened sail middle part
and lightning and rain later part the wind hauled to S S E at
daylight made sail fine weather saw white water so ends this day
Lat 38 06
Long 48 48

Saturday January 16th 1848

Begins with a strong breeze from S S E steering course S W under 4
topails at sunset shortened sail at 10 Pm wore with steamers hauled
to N at 11 later part at daylight made sail at 10 sail reef the top
sail so ends this day Lat 38 48
Long 48 14

Sunday January 17th

Begins with a strong breeze from W at 11 steering on the wind
S W by S under reef top sails at sunset took in the gill masts
and one sprinker and set the main sprinker under part the same
later part at daylight made sail set up the main top gillmast
sails and on board the gill and bent another row weather so
ends this day Lat 39 26
Long 47 41

Tuesday January 18th

Begins with a strong breeze from W at 11 steering course S W
under all sail at 1 Pm the wind hauled to S S E took in the
S W at sunset shortened sail middle part the same later part
equally and rain 3 am took in the fore topmast at daylight set it
to 10 percent weather let the reefs out of the topmasts and set gill
masts saw porpoises and porpoises so ends this day Lat 39 36
Long 47 23

Wednesday January 19th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S S E steering course S W under all
sail caught 6 porpoises and saw a small school of them at 3
Pm we tried to get soundings but could not at sunset shortened
middle part the same later part the same at daylight made sail
light made sail at 5 am the wind hauled to W S W took in the
to S by W saw a small school of porpoises and caught 6 porpoises
so ends this day Lat 41 26
Long 48 06

Thursday January 20th

Begins with a strong breeze from W at 11 steering course S W
S by W under reef top sails at sunset shortened sail 8 am took
the fore sail and took up the main topmast middle part the same later
part at daylight the sprinker hauled to S S W with a strong breeze
had 1 day the ship all hands employed reefing down fore and main
sails and main sprinker got down also and on top mast and main sprinker
so ends this day
