Saturday
Begins Sunday January 21st

Begins with a strong breeze from WNW steering on the wind
under reef topsails at 4 Pm took in the fore top sail and reef the main
topsail with heavy squalls and rain made fast the same later part of day
light made sail so ends this day

Sunday
Begins Monday January 22nd

Begins with a strong Gale from WNW steering on the wind
under reef topsails at 5 Pm shortened sail
middle part the same later part at daylight set the fore top sail
reef at 10 am set the foremast and let one reef out of the main top
sail at 11 more moderate so ends this day

Tuesday January 23rd

Begins with a strong breeze from WNW steering on the wind
under short sail at 2 Pm set the gill and spinnaker at 4 took them in
one foremast middle part the same later part at daylight made
at 10 am reef the topsails the wind from WNW steering on
W 1/2 W at 11 am took in the main sail gill and spinnaker and set the
main spinnaker so ends this day

Wednesday January 24th

Begins with a strong breeze from WNW steering on the wind
under reef fore and main topsails and foremast at 6 Pm the wind
hauled to W 1/2 W and took in the fore topsail and
fore reef and reef the main top sail one more on the reef
set middle part the same at daylight made sail and
ship to W 1/2 W the wind W 1/2 W ran a reef on our starboard
so number of foremast so ends this day

Thursday January 25th

Begins with strong breeze from WNW steering on the wind
spinnaker ship Bonaire of Chittick 34 months out 1700 hundred bls of wool
all run same of out but was not with enough to fill what they
was at some set short ten reef and more ship
at night part the same later part at daylight set the foremast
short reef fore topsails at 11 am blowing a gale took in the fore
and foremast reef and set the fore spinnaker and foremast
so ends this day

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Friday January 26th 1848

Begins with a gale from WNW heading it W by N under short
reef main topsail and spinnaker with part the same later part at daylight
made moderate main sail at 7 both spinnaker ship Bonaire of Chittick
Westward 28 months out 2800 bls of wool and 150 spinnaker
and made remaining so ends this day

Saturday January 27th

Begins with a strong breeze from WNW steering on the wind
all sail at 2 Pm took in main topsails and reef the topsails
at sunset foremast reef and left it to the wind W 1/2 W middle part the
same later part more moderate at daylight made sail all hands employed
looking out for water ran foremast and foremast so ends this day

Sunday January 28th

Begins with a light breeze from WNW steering on the wind
under all sail at 4 Pm lowered the starboard lead for foremast
but did not cut near him at 6 Pm set the spinnaker middle part the
same later part at 8 am the wind hauled to W 1/2 W and a strong breeze
in old sail except short reef main top sail and fore sail 7 am more
moderate set the fore topsail short reef at 10 the wind from W 1/2 W
heading S so ends this day

Monday January 29th

Begins with a strong breeze from WNW heading S under short
sail ran foremast middle part the same later part the wind hauled to
W 1/2 W set the gill main sail and spinnaker one reef out of the topsails
ran weather worth remaining so ends this day

Tuesday January 30th

Begins with a moderate breeze from WNW steering on the wind
under short topsails and foremast at 8 Pm the wind hauled to W 1/2 W
W 1/2 W middle part the same later part strong breeze from reef the main
and took in the main sail gill and spinnaker at 9 am set the gill and spinnaker
at 10 am upon the ship Bonaire of Chittick nearly done and from
home 150 bls of spinnaker so ends this day
