

Remarks Made On Board Bark Yemassee

Sunday March 1st 1848

Begins with a good breeze from SSW heading W under full top sail at sunset shorten sail as usual the Bark sails still insight middle part the same later part at daylight made sail at 5 Am a Gale blown at full sail in all sail except close reefed main top sail and fore spruce So ends this day

Monday March 2nd

Begins with a Gale from SSW bying too much short sail heading W the sails still insight middle part the same later part more moderate in the forenoon - evening this day

Tuesday March 3rd

Begins with a strong breeze from SSE heading SSW under reefed main top sail and fore sail at 2 Pm speak the sails as we had a good middle part the same later part at daylight made sail & Sun lost ship to SSE the wind SSW all hands employed heaving out for water rain & turtle so ends this day

Wednesday March 4th

Begins with a strong breeze from SSW heading SSE under all sail except the largest sail at sunset shorten sail middle part the wind shifted to SE later part at daylight made sail at 10 AM SSW by 8 with spruce of rain rain - transverse, turtle and 10 minutes piece of squall so ends this day

Thursday March 5th

Begins with a strong breeze from SE heading SSW under all sail and at sunset shorten sail as usual middle part present more later part the wind shifted to E at 8 kept all SSW by 8 so ends this day

Monday March 6th 1848

Begins with a strong breeze from E heading SSW by 3 miles reef top sail 4 Pm blowing hard took in all sail except close reefed main top sail and shifted to the wind SSE and set the fore spruce sail and later part the same so ends this day

Tuesday March 7th

Begins with a strong breeze from ESE more shifted to S under close reefed main top sail and fore sail middle part the wind still in evening later part at full from SE in ends this day

Sat 36 38

Wednesday March 8th

Begins with a Gale from SE bying too much short sail with thick misty weather at 1 Pm more ship to SSE middle part more moderate later part the wind shifted to SSW and almost weather was one sail and transverse So ends this day

Thursday March 9th

Begins with a moderate breeze from SSW heading SSW by 8 miles all sail middle part the same later part at evening breeze took in the fore sail and close reefed the main top sail So ends this day

Sat 33 19

Friday March 10th

Begins with a strong breeze from SSW heading SSW under all sail at 1 Pm more moderate so the fore sail and close reefed top sail middle part the same later moderate at 4 Pm more so ends this day
