

Remains Made On Board Bark Yeoman

Saturday March 11th 1848

Begins with a moderate breeze from SSW but ship to SE by E under all sail and proceeds and caught its tenth with some implem again up at topmast muller part the wind shifted to S by E later part the same same from SSW so ends this day

Sunday March 12th

Begins with a strong breeze from S by E steering course S by E under all sail at sunset shortened and left to the wind S by W with our starboard tack on board muller part light wind later part thick and hazy weather so ends this day

Monday March 13th

Begins with a strong breeze from S steering course S under all sail saw one finback at sunset shortened sail and left to the wind with our starboard tack on board muller part light wind later part some at sail steering to the Southward at daylight set the fore topmast raft the rest part of the day light breeze and thick mist

Tuesday March 14th

Begins with a light breeze from W by S steering course S by E under all sail except topmast with thick fog and rain muller part late part Baffling wind with plenty of rain saw hills so ends this day

Wednesday March 15th

Begins with a strong breeze from S by E under all sail except topmast at 2 PM spoke the Berg Anniswone of Chateaufort made 20 Monitors on 400 fathoms at 5 PM spoke the Bark Hillides of the same three months out 130 fathoms later muller part at same later part the wind from S by E ship to E at 11 PM on board the mainmast and bent down one so ends this day

Thursday March 16th 1848

Begins with a light breeze from S leading E by E under all sail the Bark Hillides still in sight and one another sail under part the wind shifted to S by E steering course S by E later part the same same one finback so ends this day

Friday March 17th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S by E steering course S by E under all sail with fine pleasant weather at 1 PM left off S by E at sunset left to the wind E by E under all sail the same water part strong breeze from S by E at 8 o'clock ship to W one sail enough so ends this day

Sog 48, 22

Saturday March 18th

Begins with a strong breeze from S by W heading W under all sail at 2 PM left the foretopmast at 5 o'clock to S by E under all sail the same water part thick misty weather so ends this day

Sog 47, 32

Sunday March 19th

Begins with a strong breeze from S by S heading S by E under all sail except topmast and foremast at sunset were ship to S by E under all sail the wind shifted to S by E steering S by E later part light air and calm with thick mist and rain so ends this day

Begins with thick and sunny with a light breeze from S by E steering my course S by S under all sail at 3 PM blowing hard took in the fore topmast and set the main and hauled to the wind with our starboard tack at sunset shortened the foremast and left the main topmast muller part later part trying to under all sail so ends this day
