

Remarks Made On Board Bark Yeamans P

Sunday March 31st 1848

Begins with a strong breeze from S.E. hauling on the main
S.E. under all sail except the fore top gallant sail with
pleasant weather at 5 Pm squally with gusts the same later part
off S. and S.W. so ends this day

Sat 35, 25 8
Long 44, 26 8

Saturday April 1st 1848

Begins with a moderate breeze from S.S.E. steering course
S. under all sail at 11 left up to S.S.W. with pleasant weather
the middle part the wind from S.E. at daylight kept off
S. by S. and S.W. and teeth so ends this day S.O.

Sunday April 2nd

Begins with a strong breeze from S.E. steering course
S. by S. under all sail top sails with thick looking weather
caught one porpoise near square and one Guil at 3 Pm
left to the wind S.E. and kept the top sails middle part
the same later part at 3 Am the wind shifted to S.S.W.
blowing hard at 4 Am more ship to W. and took in
the fore top sail at 10 A Gale so ends this day

Monday April 3rd

Begins with a Gale from S.S.W. hauling S. by S. to
under close Reef Main top sail and fore sail at 1 Took with
fore sail and set to repair small part the same later part
more moderate at daylight set the fore sail & Am more ship
to S. so ends this day

Long 45, 30 8

Tuesday April 4th

Begins with a strong breeze from S.S.W. hauling S.E.
under close Reef main top sail and fore sail at 4 Pm set
the fore top sail close Reef and set sail steering on the
wind so that we are middle part moderate. later part at 2 Pm
more ship to west at daylight more sail and took to S.E.
more moderate the fore sail and set sail and set sail
uplock in breaking out the water

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Wednesday April 5th 1848

Begins with a moderate breeze from S.W. hauling S.S.E.
under all sail one sail inight at sunset shorten sail and
middle part the wind from W. S. W. and one sail later
part the same so ends this day

Long 45, 35 8

Thursday April 6th

Begins with a good breeze from W. S. W. hauling S.W.
under all sail with pleasant weather at sunset shorten
sail middle part the same later part strong winds darkened
at daylight inside sail and fore top sail and set sail
so ends this day

Sat 36, 39 8
Long 46, 29 8

Friday April 7th

Begins with a strong breeze from S.W. hauling
westward under all top sails at 3 Pm set the fore sail
and took in the S. S. W. main sail and fore sail at sunset
took in the fore top sail and short reef the main sail
part blowing hard later part at 2 Pm the wind shifted
to S.S.W. hauling S.E. at daylight more moderate at 8 Am
took to W. S. W. and fore top sail so ends this day Sat

Long

Saturday April 8th

Begins with a strong breeze from S.S.W. hauling S.
under all top sail at sunset calm shorten sail for the
night middle part a light breeze from S.E. steering course S.S.W.
later part the same moderate return up the fore top sail at 10
later saw porpoises so ends this day

Sat 36, 29
Long 47, 31

Sunday April 9th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S.E. steering course
S.S.W. under all sail and down the main & fore top
sails at sunset shorten sail and left to the wind
with one fore top sail, short haul haul S.E. with last the
same later at daylight made sail at 4 Am kept off S.
S.W. saw squall and teeth so ends this day Sat
