

Monday April 10th 1848  
Begins with a strong breeze from the Northward steering  
course S 38° with pleasant weather 1 P.M. light to S 38° in green  
water at sunset shorten sail and last to the second mill  
put thick weather later part at 3 P.M. a squall of wind with  
thunder and lightning at 7 P.M. the wind from the Westward  
but to S 38° by W rain this day  
Lat 37, 22  
Long 48, 35

Tuesday April 11th  
Begins with a moderate breeze from S 38° heading  
W under all sail still in green water mill part the  
same later part light and baffling wind employed setting up  
the main top Gallant backstay saw a Sampson and 2  
ramparts 20 ends this day  
Lat 36, 58  
Long 48, 36

Wednesday April 12th  
Begins with light air and calm with pleasant weather  
this saw a Finback at sunset a light breeze from  
S heading 38° at 4 P.M. shortened sail middle part the same  
later part a strong breeze from S 38° 20 ends this day  
Lat  
Long

Thursday April 13th  
Begins with a strong breeze from S 38° heading  
W under all sail at sunset last to E 38° and  
shorten sail mill and later part a thick looking weather  
the wind from S 38° 20 ends this day No Obs

Friday April 14th  
Begins with a strong breeze from S 38° heading  
W under all sail saw a Sampson at sunset shorten  
sail mill part the same later part at 1 P.M. the wind  
hauled to E and altered the course to S 38° saw two  
sails and 20 rumparts 20 ends this day  
Lat 36, 13  
Long 48, 36

Saturday April 15th 1848  
Begins with a moderate breeze from E steering course  
S under all sail at 1 altered the course to S by 38°  
with pleasant weather at sunset shorten sail mill part  
at 10 P.M. the wind from W and thick looking weather heading  
N 38° saw a Finback 20 ends this day No Obs  
Lat 35, 42

Sunday April 16th  
Begins with a strong breeze from N 38° heading N 38°  
under all sail saw one sail back steering to the South  
ward showing white signal with 2 red gunners middle  
part light breeze later part baffling wind with rain clearing  
at 10 P.M. saw one Finback 20 ends this day No Obs

Monday April 17th  
Begins with weather and rain a strong breeze from  
N steering course N 38° under all sail at 1 P.M. the  
wind hauled to S 38° altered the course to S by 38°  
at 4 a Spanish Brig steering to Westward at sunset  
red hat weather mill part light to same later part light  
air and calm air fresh clearing ship at 1 P.M. saw  
breeze from S 20 ends this day  
Lat 33, 25  
Long 47, 17

Tuesday April 18th  
Begins with a moderate breeze from N steering with  
wind N 38° under all sail every to go to North  
ward mill part the same later part at 1 P.M. sharp light  
in the S 38° at 12 the wind hauled to S 38° last ship  
and kept off at 1 P.M. with a strong breeze and plenty  
of rain at 3 took in the top Sails 20 ends this day  
Lat 32, 07  
Long

Wednesday April 19th Begins with a strong wind  
from S 38° steering course S 38° under all sail Spanish mill  
forward with thick and rain at 2 kept the Spanish at  
4 P.M. clear weather at 8 blowing hard east kept the  
Spanish mill and later part the same 20 ends this day  
Lat 29, 25  
Long 48, 43
