Saturday June 3rd 1848
 Begins with a strong breeze from S.E. steering course
 N.E. by E under all sail except the fore top sheet sail
 sail used flying jib at 4 PM set the flying jib mable
 part moderate breeze steering N.E. by E latter part the same
 To end this day Lat 02, 21.5
 Long 37 45

Sunday June 4th
 Begins with a moderate breeze from E.S.E. steering
 course N.E. by E under all sail was a school of Porpoises
 Porpoises at 4 PM course N.E. mable part the same
 latter part at 7 PM saw the land for Black Port
 with out glasses To end this day Lat 00 40.8
 Long 30 47.8

Monday June 5th
 Begins with moderate breeze from S.E. steering
 course N.E. by E under all sail mable part the same latter
 part employed repairing the boat saw nothing worth
 remarking To end this day Lat 01 15.4
 Long 30 15.4

Tuesday June 6th
 Begins with light breeze from S.E. steering
 course N.E. by E under all sail saw a school of Porpoises
 part the boat the wind from S.E. latter part the boat out
 for water still employed repairing on the boat To end
 this day Lat 03 14.4

Wednesday June 7th
 Begins with a light breeze from S.E. steering course
 N.E. by E under all sail one sail mable part
 the wind hauled to N.E. steering N.E. by E latter part the
 wind employed repairing the boat To end this day Lat 04 31.8

Thursday June 8th
 Begins with a light breeze from E.S.E. steering course
 N.E. by E under all sail at sunset changed to N.E. by E
 mable part light breeze which was plenty of rain
 at 10 PM went to the flying jib To end this day
 Lat 05 06.3

Friday June 9th 1848
 Begins with light and hailing wind steering course N.E. by E
 and plenty of rain mable part the same latter part pleasant
 weather mable part the boat To end this day
 Lat 06 14.8

Saturday June 10th
 Begins with light and hailing wind from all points
 of the compass see a school of porpoises mable part the
 weather latter part the wind from N.E. To end this day
 Lat 07 58.8
 Long 30 27.8

Sunday June 11th
 Begins with a moderate trade from S.E. steering
 on the wind S.E. by E under all sail at 4 PM part
 the repair boat saw dead saw nothing worth remarking
 mable part strong breeze latter part the same see a
 school of porpoises To end this day Lat 09 52.8
 Long 31 51.8

Monday June 12th
 Begins with fine pleasant weather the trade from
 from S.E. steering on the wind S.E. by E mable part
 mable part the same latter part steering N.E. by E implied
 fishing over the potatoes and potatoes the darkest boat
 over head saw nothing worth remarking Lat 10 16.8
 Long 33 05.8

Tuesday June 13th
 Begins with a moderate trade from E.S.E. steering
 course N.E. by E under all sail mable part the same latter
 part employed repairing the flying jib on end the day
 Lat 11 46.8

Wednesday June 14th
 Begins with a moderate breeze from S.E. steering on
 on the wind S.E. by E under all sail employed mable part
 mable part hailing wind latter strong breeze at 10 PM
 sent the flying jib To end this day Lat 13 15.8
 Long 35 36.8
