Sunday June 25th 1848
Begin with light breeze from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail at 2 P.M. tack to S^W & S^W under all sail at sunset shorten sail for the night and set boat's crew watches middle part the same latter part at daylight made sail saw small white whales so ends this day
Lat 31, 37.8
Long 46, 37.8

Monday June 26th 1848
Begin with light breeze from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail at 4 calm at sunset light breeze from S^W & S^W tack to S^W & S^W and shorten sail for the night middle part the same latter part at daylight made sail and kept off S^W all hands implor'd backing out for water and getting the rig in on the top gallant yards so ends this day

Tuesday June 27th
Begin with light air and Calms under all sail all hands in place getting the rig in saw northern whales some 12 miles and latter part the same at 12 hours the boats for Kilbar with out success so ends this day

Begin with 10 Calm at school of killers in sight at 2 P.M. so light breeze from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail at sunset tack to S^W & S^W and shorten sail middle and latter part strong breezes from S^W & S^W so ends this day

Thursday June 29th
Begin with at strong breeze from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail at sunset shorten sail at sunset shorten sail middle part pleasant weather latter part at daylight made sail at 4 at no light air or rain saw small white whales so ends this day

Remarks Made On Board Bark Yeoman

Friday June 30th 1848
Begin with thick squally and rainy weather the wind from S^W steering course E by S under all sail at sunset shorten sail and lift to the wind with one barbed sails at dusk middle part pleasant weather latter part the same saw small white whales so ends this day

Long 46, 39.8

Saturday June July 1st 1848
Begin with fair pleasant weather the wind from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail at sunset saw Black Bird and one sail middle part the same latter part had the wind from S^W heading S^W & S^W one sail steering to the Eastward but all hands implor'd on the rig in so ends this day
Lat 32, 35.8

Sunday June 2nd
Begin with at strong breeze from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail except the fore top gallant sail at 4 P.M. took in the light quibo and reefed the top sail & the squalls of rain at sunset shorten sail middle and latter part the same at daylight made sail saw one Bark steering to the Eastward at 7 P.M. the wind tacked to S^W & S^W tack to S^W & S^W so ends this day

Monday July 3rd
Begin with at strong breeze from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail except the fore top gallant sail at sunset shorten sail at sunset shorten sail middle and latter part the same saw small white whales so ends this day

Begin with strong breeze from S^W heading S^W & S^W under all sail at sunset shorten sail at sunset shorten sail middle part pleasant weather latter part at daylight made sail at 4 at no light air or rain saw small white whales so ends this day
