Wednesday July 5th 1848

Begins with ~~light~~ light breeze from S.W. heading W.S.W. under all sail and pleasant weather northward insight implead in piten the rig's middle part the same latter part the wind shifted to S.W. at daylight 10 made sail and kept off at 7 P.M. saw sperm whales at 10 P.M. landed the boats and struck two in company with the Brig Challenger of Newport 14 miles and with 100 lbs 12 P.M. took the whales at long. side 40 ends this day

Thursday June 6th

Begins with light breeze from S.W. heading W.S.W. at 1 P.M. commenced cutting in the whale at 3 P.M. landed the boats for more. ~~Whales~~ Whales with out success at 3 P.M. finished cutting in these at 4 P.M. landed two local, the darkest boat struck at sunset struck him at long side at 7 P.M. from speak the Brig Challenger of Challenger commenced cutting the whale at 10 commenced boiling 3 barrels in sight no ends this day

Begins with fine pleasant weather implead boiling with the wind from S.W. heading S.W. mid E and latter part the same one Brig insight and Black fish at 9 P.M. struck to E.S. no ends this day

Begins with light breeze from S.W. heading E.S. under all sail all hands implead boiling out the whales at 4 P.M. from the Brig America of Challenger middle part the same latter part at 4 P.M. finished boiling out the whales at 7 P.M. kept off E.S. no ends this day

Begins with pleasant weather with the wind from S.W. steering course E.S. saw 30 fath of sperm whale carcass and struck one at 4 P.M. took him at long side middle part the same latter part commenced cutting in no ends this day

Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. heading E.S. implead cutting in the whale at 5 P.M. finished cutting 6 P.M. took 20 long small of sperm whale carcass at 7 commenced boiling out the whale middle and latter part the same the wind from the Eastward heading S.W. no ends this day

Tuesday July 11th

Begins with strong winds from the Eastward heading S.W. and stiff weather still implead boiling middle part the same and latter part the same no ends this day

Wednesday June 12th

Begins with fine pleasant weather the wind from E heading S.W. still boiling at 1 P.M. more ship to S.W. middle and latter part light breeze at 5 P.M. finish boiling out at 6 P.M. the bare ~~sperm~~ carcass and have and kept off S.W. no ends this day

Begins with light breeze from S.W. steering course S.W. under short sail one Bark steering to the Eastward at sunset kept to the wind with the darkest boat at 10 P.M. took him at long side middle part the same latter part at daylight commenced storing down no ends this day
