Monday July 24th 1848

Begins with light breeze from W heading course E by S under all sail some light steam ship steaming E by S middle and latter part light air and calm saw Grampians several porpoises so ends this day

Tuesday July 25th

Begins with light breeze and calm one Brig in company with ~~the~~ captured the American of Massachusetts name Grampian middle and latter part the same under the Brig
Sighting so ends this day

Wednesday June 26th

Begins with light breeze and calm in place getting the rig in middle part the same latter part light breeze from S W steering course ~~W~~ E saw a ship steering to S W saw a number of Grampians and white water so ends this day

Thursday July 27th

Begins with light breeze from S W steering to E by E under all sail all hands employed getting the rig in saw 2 Grampians at sunset left to the wind middle and latter part the same at daylight kept off E by E so ends this day

Begins with light breeze from ~~W~~ S W at 1 PM kept to W S W under all sail middle part the wind hauled to E by E latter part the same at 7 PM kept off W at 7 kept to the wind saw several all hands employed getting the rig in

Saturday July 29th 1848

Begins with light breeze from S E heading S by W under all sail all hands employed in the rig in at 6 PM kept to E by E middle part the same latter part at 7 PM kept off S at 11 kept to the wind with the Starboard tack, about so ends this day

Sunday July 30th

Begins with fine pleasant weather the wind S E heading S by E under all sail in place getting the rig in at sunset kept to E by E middle part the same latter part the wind hauled to S E at 7 kept to E by E so ends this day

Monday July 31st

Begins with light breeze from S E heading E by E under all sail saw nothing worth remarking middle and latter part the same saw white water so ends this day

Tuesday August 1st 1848

Begins with light breeze from S E heading E by E under all sail except fore topgallant sail and flying jib middle part light breeze saw porpoises all hands employed getting the rig in so ends this day

Wednesday August 2nd

Begins with light breeze from S E heading E by E under all sail at 3 PM hauled the Boat for Black Fish with out success at 5 wore Ship to S W middle part steering course S the wind E latter part baffling and squally

Break out for water so ends this day

Thursday August 3rd

Begins with strong breeze from S E heading S by E toward toward the boat for Black Fish with out success middle part light breeze latter part the same from S E at 7 PM kept off S W so ends this day
