

Remarks made On Board Bark Yemum

Sunday August 15th 1848

Begins with moderate breeze from S & steering course Sth at 1 Pm altered it to Sth at sunset left to the wind middle part heading the same latter part at 9 took tack to E saw black fish 20 or 30 ends this day

Monday August 16th

Begins with a good breeze from S & heading E under all sail saw goldfinch and one Sail steering Sth middle part had the wind S & at 12 were ship to Sth latter part at 11½ kept off W & S so ends this day

Tuesday August 17th

Begins with moderate breeze from S & steering course W & S under all sail implied rearing the rig at sunset left to the wind middle part the same latter part had the wind from E heading S & implied turning down the rig so ends this day

Wednesday August 18th

Begins with moderate breeze from E heading S & under all sail all hands implied sailing down the rig middle part the same latter part implied furling the upper so ends this day

Thursday August 19th

Begins with light breeze from E heading S & under all sail and pleasant weather implied furling the upper middle and latter part the same so ends this day

Friday August 20th

Begins with strong breeze from S & heading S & under all sail saw Grampsey at 5 Pm took to Sth & middle part at 12 were ship to S & latter part clearing the same so ends this day

Monday August 21st 1848

Begins with strong breeze from S & heading S & under all sail saw Grampsey at 5 Pm took to Sth & middle part at 12 were ship to S & latter part clearing the same so ends this day

Tuesday August 22nd

Begins with a moderate breeze from S & steering course S & under all sail implied sailing up the fore and after topmast back star mill and latter part the same saw Sails in sight so ends this day

Wednesday 23rd

Begins with moderate breeze from S & heading E at 1 Pm speak the Brig Muffin of New Bedford 14 months out 2000 lbs sperm oil 1000 master mill and latter part the same saw Sails at the command so ends this day

Thursday August 24th

Begins with a good breeze from S heading S & under all sail saw Grampsey at sunset took to the westward on Whaling Bark in sight all hands implied clearing the fore & middle heading the same latter part at 8 Pm speak the Bark Fairy of New Bedford 14 months out 3000 sperm oil ends this day

Friday August 25th

Begins with moderate breeze from S heading S & under all sail sailing in company with the Fairy at sunset she went to sea and got 4000 lbs of sperm and 1000 of oil at 8 were ship to the westward middle and latter part the same

Begins with a strong breeze from W & S heading S & under all sail at 2 Pm took in the flying Sails main top gallant mill and kept the fore top sail and took to the westward middle and latter part equally so ends this day
