

Remarks Made On Board Bark Yeoman

Sunday August 27th 1848

Begin with strong breeze from W^W heading S^W under reefed topsail at 4 P.M. took the S at sunset speak the Brig Mattaponeit of Westport 19 months out 200 lbs muller muller put light breeze heading to Eastward

Monday August 28th

Begin with moderate breeze from W^W heading S^W under all sail saw one seal swimming middle part the same latter part squalls of wind and rain the current from all points of the compass no end this day

Tuesday August 29th

Begin with thick and squally weather the wind from all points of the compass at 3 P.M. present weather the signal from S steering course W^W by N for two sails, might at 6 left to the wind middle part heading the same latter part heavy squalls of wind and rain saw two blackbird men steering to E^{SE} no end this day

Wednesday August 30th

Begin with strong breeze from W^W steering course E under hole topsails at sunset took the boat for Black Point with out ~~water~~ saws at middle part heading on the wind latter part at 7 P.M. kept her of E no end this day

Thursday August 31st

Begin with strong breeze from W^W steering course E under reefed topsails and squally with showers saw many herring the boat at 3 P.M. took in all sail except starboard reefed main topsail and deck ~~at~~ the wind with sea starboard tack at sunset middle part the same latter part more moderate net the fore sail and fore topsail reefed and kept off E no end this day

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Friday September 1st 1848

Begin with strong breeze from W^W steering course E under all sail ^{at sunset} saw ^{two} seals ⁱⁿ middle part heading out for Flower and bread mill part light breeze latter part the same at daylight kept of E implead towing down the fore and aft sails no end this day

Saturday Sept 2nd

Begin with light breeze from W^W steering course E under all sail implead towing down the rigging middle and latter part the same breeze out for water saw nothing worth remarking no end this day

18.00

Sunday Sept 3rd

Begin with pleasant weather with moderate breeze from W^W steering course E under all sail middle part the same latter part had the wind from W^W with heavy swell saw nothing worth remarking no end this day

Monday Sept 4th

Begin with moderate breeze from W^W steering course E under all sail at sunset the weather the course to E by S middle part the wind hauled to S^{SE} latter part the same no end this day

Tuesday Sept 5th

Begin with light breeze from S^{SE} heading E^{SE} under all sail saw 16 Furbock middle part the same latter part had the wind S^{SE} at 7 P.M. took ship to E^{SE} saw one Furbock no end this day

Wednesday Sept 6th

Begin with moderate breeze from S^{SE} steering course E^{SE} under all sail saw 16 Brig steering Westward middle part the same latter part the wind from S^{SE} saw nothing worth remarking no end this day
