

Remarks Made On Board Barb Y

Thursday Sept 7th 1848

Begins with strong breeze from SSW steering course
E S E under all sail at 4 Pm altered the course to E at
sunset shorten sail as usual mill part of the same latter
part at daylight saw the Isle of Flores bearing S E dis-
tance 45 miles at 10 Am lowered the boat for Black
Sick one boat struck the iron strip parted and lost nine
men & number of Sails so much this day

Friday Sept 8th

Begins with strong breeze from SSW heading on shore
S E at 1 Pm speak the Ship Soley of Amsterdam
master Gils reaches from down down at sunset part of
shore visible part at 12. Foot looking in shore at daylight part
part of shore at 8 Am the Captain went in shore with 8
boats crew but did not land at 9 am on shore again
the strong breeze and squally crew the ship steering
S E around this day heading of shore

Saturday Sept 9th

Begins with strong breeze from SSW heading on shore
at 1 Pm part to S E in shore at 4 Pm speak
the Ship Soley and gained mill part the same latter part
standing up and on the Captain on shore to St George because
for recruit so ends this day

Sunday Sept 10th

Begins with strong breeze from SSW heading of coast on
at the town of St George the Captain close shore at sunset
sun below and sent 10 boats full of potatoes and some
wines and fresh ditch on shore mill and latter part steering
S E so ends this day

Remarks Made On Board Barb Y

Monday Sept 11th 1848

Begins with strong breeze from SSW steering course S E under
raft topmast, gill and courses, nine Squid and white water
mill part equally and thunder at night saw the Isle of
Graciosa bearing S E distant 15 miles at 10 Am
lost of shore to the Westward so ends this day the crew
the Chronometer 35 miles to the Eastward

Tuesday Sept 12th

Begins with strong breeze from SSW heading W under all
sail crossing of the S E of Graciosa at 4 Pm part
of the lower land of the Island at sunset speak the Brig
Persillon of Chimerich three months out 68 days mill and
latter part light breeze so ends this day

Wednesday 13th

Begins with moderate breeze from the Westward steering to
S E under all sail mill part now at sunset speak the Brig American
with one gained mill part the same latter part steering S S E in our
company and the Brig around this day S E of St J
about being S S E

Thursday 14th

Begins with light breeze from S W steering course S S E under
all sail the Isle of St Michael bearing S E at sunset three sails
might remaining most remaining mill part S E day 6 latter part
the wind from S W steering part the land in company with
the American some fragments so ends this day

Friday Sept 15th

Begins with light breeze from S W steering course S S E
by S under all sail in company with the B. American at 5 Pm
we were of the town of St Michael at sunset part of S
the wind shifted to S E mill part the same latter part the
wind from S E at 7 Pm lowered the boat for Black
Sick without success so ends this day
