same so ends

Dec Monday 2-1901 these day begins with
fresh breeze and squally weather
steer S.W. by S. latter part the
same so ends

Dec Tuesday 3-1901 these day begins with
light breeze and clear weather
latter part the same
one sail in sight heading
to the northward steer S.W.
broke out beans sugar and
oil moved new fore-top sail
braces so ends

with light breeze and clear
weather running steer S.W.
latter part the same so ends

saw tow sails so ends
