Wednesday 25-1901 these day begins with fresh gale and cloudy weather under short sail latter part the same so ends

Thursday 26-1901 these day begins with fresh gale and squally weather and sail in sight latter part the same under short sail so ends

Lat 34.01 Long 48.42

Dec

Friday 27-1901 these day begins with fresh southeast wind and cloudy weather at 7.30 a.m. got three men on Irons Anthony Perry and Mammal Garcia Luis got fighting ~~between~~ and James Hillman stroke Mammal Garcia Luis so got all three on Irons at 10 a.m. let James go but kept the other two until 7 p.m. at sun set short down sail saw grampers so ends

Saturday 28-1901 these day begins with light Southeast wind and clear weather saw grampers latter part the same keep tow men on deck fore position so ends

Sunday 29-1901 these day begins with light northeast wind and cloudy weather saw grampers and one steamer latter part the same at sun set short down sail tow lower topsail so ends

Lat 35.20 Long 48.29

Dec

Monday 30-1901 these day begins with light northwest wind and heavy swell at 1.30 p.m. raised school of sperm whales going quick to the windward at sun set short down sail tow lower topsails and stay sails brock out flour and hams and water and beef so ends

Lat 34.55 S Long 47.37 W

Dec

Tuesday 31-1901 these day begins with fresh S.W. wind and clear weather running steer N.W. at 11.20 a.m. raised three large whales on the stern did not see them again latter part calm so ends
