saw grampers to end

fresh gale and clear wind from
the northern one sail latter part
the same to end

Saturday 4-1902 these day begins with
fresh gale and clear day to under
lower main top sail and stay sail

broke out water to end

Sunday 5-1902 these day begins with
fine weather whole sail out
clear saw black fish and grampers
to end latter part the
same

Monday 6-1902 these day begins with
fresh northerly wind and cloud
latter part fresh gale with
heavy squalls at sea set moderate
some and clear under lower
main top sail to end

Tuesday 7-1902 these day begins with
fresh gale and clear wind from
northwest saw grampers - latter
part moderate some to end

Wednesday 8-1902 these day begins with
light southerly wind and cloudy weather
whole sail out saw grampers - latter part
the same to end

Thursday 9-1902 these day begins with
light easterly wind and clear weather
heading to the northern whale day
at one p.m. raised a bark ahead
whaling see her teeth one whale
longside and one other boat fast
at sundown short sail to end

Friday 10-1902 these day begins with
fine weather good breeze spoke horse
grayhound with 7. whales alongside and
took on deck two other sails in sight
at sundown short sail to end
