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Thursday 20-1902 these day begins with fresh easterly wind and tech weather heading to the northern whole sail out latter part the same at 6.30 p.m. locking the light sails so ends

Lat 29.20 Long 42.31

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Friday 21-1902 these day begins with fresh easterly wind and tech weather latter part the same under short sail first part heading to the north latter southeast so ends

Lat 28.25 Long 42.47

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Saturday 22-1902 these day begins with fresh easterly wind and tech weather under short sail broke out water latter part the same so ends

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Sunday 23-1902 these day begins with fresh easterly wind and clear weather one sail in sight latter part the same under short sail so ends

Lat 29.24 Long 41.11

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Monday 24-1902 these day begins with fresh northerly wind and cloudy under short sail heading E. F. E. V. latter part the same so ends

Tuesday 25-1902 these day begins with fresh northerly wind and squally weather latter part heavy rain and calm so ends

wednesday 26-1902 these day begins with calm and heavy rain latter part light easterly wind and clear weather heading southeast so ends

Thursday 27-1902 these day begins with light easterly wind and clear weather the whole sail out head east latter part the same so ends

Friday 28-1902 these day begins with light northerly wind and clear at work on the blocks over hall and making new strips latter part the same so ends
