May Sunday 18-1902 these day begins with calm and cloudy at 1 p.m. raised school small whales drop down three boats S.B. got fast on small can other boats chase but did not get old came on board at 3 p.m. put up the gear and start eating at 8 p.m. got true so ends

May Monday 19-1902 these day begins with light southerly wind and squally boiling latter part the same got true boiling at 9.30 p.m. so ends

Tuesday 20-1902 these day begins with light southerly wind and squally stored the oil closer and broke out water latter part the same so ends

Lat 32.00 Long 51.15

Wednesday 21-1902 these day begins with fresh southeasterly wind and squally at 10.15 a.m. raised school of small whales drop three boats second mate ~~and~~ running them over chase but did not get any at 12.30. came on board latter part the same so ends

Lat 32.15 Long 50.17

Thursday 22-1902 these day begins with fresh southerly wind and squally weather latter part more moderate saw porpoises so ends

Lat 32.08 Long 49.54

Friday 23-1902 these day begins with rainy squally and heavy sea latter part cloudy under short sail so ends

Saturday 24-1902 these day begins with squally and light southerly wind two sail in sight one ship and a schooner latter part the same so ends

Sunday 25-1902 these day begins with light southeasterly wind and clear one whaling schooner in sight latter part the same so ends
