

July Sunday 13-1902 these day begins with light rain and cloudy at 11.30 a.m. raised a lone whale drop two boats got fast and boat got stove L. B. S. B. went on and got fast parch W. B. with canvas and drop at 11.30 p.m. got the stove boat a long side so ends

July Monday 14-1902 these day start cutting get the head off and body in at 7.30 p.m. got suppers boiling the head a long side so ends

July Tuesday 15-1902 these day begins with fine weather pump out water and stored oil down at 2 p.m. start on the head bell the case and got the junk in at the works so ends

July Wednesday 16-1902 these day begins with fine weather at day light two whaling schooners in side spout both at 3 p.m. chase and golden city boiling and cut up junk at the works so ends

Lat 34.14 Long 52.14

July Thursday 17-1902 these day begins with calm at 7 a.m. light air chase raised a lone whale and drop two boat pump out water and stored oil down got one boat off the house and started up the L. B. up so ends Lat 34.17 Long 51.14

Friday 18-1902 these day begins with light W. winds and clear weather lay up decks and repair the W. B. latter part the same two scho. in sight so ends Lat 34.17 Long 52.18

Saturday 19-1902 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and thick weather running star E. one schooner in sight latter part the same so ends Lat 34.30

Sunday 20-1902 these day begins with light southerly winds and overcast latter part the same saw grampers so ends Lat 34.20 Long 51.37

Monday 21-1902 these day begins with fresh southwesterly winds and rainy squally latter part moderate some under short sail so ends Lat 34.09

Tuesday 22-1902 these day begins with calm and clear weather at 8 a.m. light air from NW. latter part the same so ends Lat 34.20 Long 51.01

Wednesday 23-1902 these day begins with light westerly wind clear weather saw grampers latter part the same so ends Lat 34.57 Long 51.11
