W.B. got fast came a lounge side at 6.30 p.m. all hand got suppers so ends Sat 34.30 Long 50.58

Friday 25-1902 these day begins with westerly winds and clear weather at 5 a.m. start cutting at 1 p.m. got true latter part the sun. saw grampers at 3 p.m. start bailing so ends Sat 34.14 Long 51.08

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Saturday 26-1902 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and squally weather boiling one whaling schr in sight latter part clear got true boat at 9 p.m. so ends Sat 34.00 Long 50.42

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Sunday 27-1902 these day begins with fine weather light northeasterly wind and clear stored oil down at 2 p.m. got all the oil down clear & up clear latter part the same so end Sat 34.00 Long 50.42

Monday 28-1902 these day begins with light westerly winds and clear weather latter part the same so ends Sat 34.12 Long 51.08

Tuesday 29-1902 these day begins with calm and clear spoke a much man and send a letter home by her going to Bermuda at 12.30 p.m. saw a vessel mast with all raggain on drop one boat and bind a lounge side took all the raggain out of it. 6. sericles and one blood latter part the same so ends Sat 34.19

Wednesday 30-1902 these day begins with calm at 6 a.m. raised whales drop three boats got fast came a lounge side at 10 a.m. bailing working on the hold clear up the shacks heads ready to stored oil down at the work so ends Sat 34.47 Long 51.08

Thursday 31-1902 these day begins with fine weather at 7 a.m. start cutting at 11 a.m. got true bell the case and cutting up gins working in the hold latter part the same so ends Sat 34.41 Long 51.16

Friday 1-1902 these day begins with heavy raining squally latter part clear up some one bark and a schr in sight bailing both of them we bailing all so ends
