

Aug Thursday 21-1902 these day begins with fine weather light S.W. winds and clear start cutting at 5.15 a.m. at 11.40 a.m. got all the whale in get dinner and fell the case at 2 p.m. start boiling cut up junk at 6 p.m. get supper at the works so ends
Cut 34.45 Long 46.39

Aug Friday 22-1902 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and clear weather boiling and stored oil down latter part the same at the works so ends
Cut 35.08 Long 46.45

Aug Saturday 23-1902 these day begins with fine weather light southerly winds and clear got true stored oil down full ship latter part wash off deck so ends
Cut 35.21 Long 46.00

Aug Sunday 24-1902 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear weather steer by the wind latter part calm so ends
Cut 35.25 Long 44.58

Aug Monday 25-1902 these day begins with fresh easterly winds and clear weather one whaling schr in sight two steamer, repair to boat latter part the same under short sail heading to the southward so ends
Cut 35.25 Long 44.46

Tuesday 26-1902 these day begins with fresh gale and heavy squally from southerly latter part the same under lower main top sail and stay sail so ends

Wednesday 27-1902 these day begins with fresh southerly gale and squally under main top sail and stay sails latter part the same heavy swell at sun set moderate some so ends

Thursday 28-1902 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and squally weather running steer E.S.E. latter part light westerly winds and clear the whole sail out and sail in sight brock out part and sugar so ends
Cut 35.59 Long 42.16

Friday 29-1902 these day begins with light northerly winds and clear weather steer E. at 1.20 p.m. raised school of small whales drop three boats did not get any come on board at 4.30 p.m. at sun set was school of black fish latter part the same so ends
Cut 36.04 Long 40.40

Saturday 30-1902 these day begins with light northerly winds and clear weather latter part the same running steer E. 1/2 N. so ends
Cut 36.24 Long 39.15
