

Dec Tuesday 2-1902 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear three sails in sight one steamer saw finback latter part the same so ends Lat 24.35. S. Long 89.13.

Dec Wednesday 3-1902 these day begins with light air from northern three sails in sight latter part the same so ends

Dec Thursday 4-1902 these day begins with light easterly winds and cloudy and sail in sight latter part light rainy steer S.W. so ends Lat 26.00. S.

Dec Friday 5-1902 these day begins with light southerly winds and squally at a.m. fresh breezes with rain latter part moderate same so ends Lat 27.17 S. at noon

Dec Saturday 6-1902 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear weather saw finback latter part the same the whole sail out so ends Lat 27.32 S. Long 43.04. W.

Dec Sunday 7-1902 these day begins with fresh northerly winds and clear running steer S.W. latter part squally and over cast under short sail so ends Lat 28.25. S.

Monday 8-1902 these day begins with heavy rain light winds from southwest latter part clear saw black fish so ends Lat 30.10. S. Long 43.50. W.

Tuesday 9-1902 these day begins with fresh S.W. winds and cloudy weather latter part the same under short sail one sail in sight head to westward so ends Lat 30.51 S. Long 44.16

Wednesday 10-1902 these day begins with calm and heavy swell from S.W. at 10 a.m. begins with light northeasterly winds and clear latter part fresh northeast saw grampass steer S.W. under short sail tamer topsails and fore sail so ends Lat 30.49 Long 44.45

Thursday 11-1902 these day begins with fresh northerly winds and squally light rain latter part moderate down to calm one three master schooner in sight going to the northward short down sail at sundown so ends

Friday 12-1902 these day begins with light southerly winds clear weather saw black fish grampass and fin back porpoise latter part the same so ends Lat 32.24 S. Long 46.00. W.

Saturday 13-1902 these day begins with fresh northeasterly winds and thick weather at noon raised school of small whales drop down three boats two got fast
