

Feb Saturday 7-1903 these day begins with heavy northern and squally carrying away the main sail and fore up top sail bend and main sail latter part the same sails
Lat 26.25 Long 30.09

Feb Sunday 8-1903 these day begins with heavy northern and heavy swell cloudy latter part moderate some under short sail heading NE. 50 ends
Lat 25.30 Long 28.16

Feb Monday 9-1903 these day begins with heavy northern and heavy squalls latter part moderate some heading to the eastwards 50 ends Lat 24.30 Long 27.57

Feb Tuesday 10-1903 these day begins with light northerly winds and cloudy heading to the eastwards latter part the same brock out water and break 50 ends Lat 24.10 Long 27.18

Feb Wednesday 11-1903 these day begins with calm and clear weather latter part the same made new main sheet 50 ends Lat 23.35 Long 27.10

Feb Thursday 12-1903 these day begins with calm and clear working on the head gear one of the gib giers is all gone latter part the same 50 ends

Friday 13-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear weather running steer N.W. latter part the same 50 ends Lat 22.52 Long 27.47

Feb Saturday 14-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and squally weather one sail insight running steer N.W. latter part the same brock out flour 50 ends Lat 21.37 Long 28.48

Feb Sunday 15-1903 these day begins with heavy NE. squally short down sail under two lower topsails heading NW. latter part the same had a sower have 6 little peags 50 ends Lat 19.33

Feb Monday 16-1903 these day begins with heavy northeast squalls latter part light speak an english man his Long 32.19 mine 31.13 & killed a hog 50 ends Lat 18.28 Long 31.13

Feb Tuesday 17-1903 these day begins with light easterly winds and squally one sail insight heading to the southern latter part the same heading N.E. 50 ends Lat 16.31 Long 32.42

Feb Wednesday 18-1903 these day begins with light easterly winds and squally weather latter part the same 50 ends Lat 14.38 Long 32.42
