

Mar wednesday 4-1903 these day begins with light northeasterly winds and squally latter part clear steer by the winds heading NW. and N.W. so ends

Lat 00.14 S. Long 30.410 W.

Mar Thursday 5-1903 these day begins with light northeasterly winds and squally latter part the same steer by the winds so ends

Mar Friday 6-1903 these day begins with light easterly winds and squally three steamers in sight latter part the same so ends Lat 00.57 N.

Mar Saturday 7-1903 these day begins with light northeasterly winds and squally weather steer by the wind got head squall carry away the fore top gable sail latter part the same so ends Lat 02.10 N.

Mar Sunday 8-1903 these day begins with fresh northeast and squally weather latter part the same so ends Lat 3.17 N.

Mar Monday 9-1903 these day begins with fresh breezes and overcast steer by the wind repair the fore top gable sail and bend and set up latter part the same so ends Lat 04.59 N. Long 34.56

Tuesday 10-1903 these day begins with light breezes and overcast steer by the wind latter part the same so ends Lat 06.51 N.

Wednesday 11-1903 these day begins with fresh breezes and cloudy steer by the wind latter part the same Thomas Samuel lay up sick saw granders so ends Lat 08.38 N. Long 37.15 W.

Thursday 12-1903 these day begins with light breezes and clear weather saw one sail going to the W. latter part the same steer by the wind so ends Lat 10.42 N. Long 38.26 W.

Friday 13-1903 these day begins with fresh breezes and cloudy weather saw a fin back latter part the same at noon took in two top gable sails flying jib mizen top must stay sail so ends Lat 13.05 N. Long 39.44 W.

Saturday 14-1903 these day begins with fresh breezes and squally weather cruising running first part steer SW. latter part NW. at 4 p.m. all up on the wind so ends Lat 13.02 Long 40.23

Sunday 15-1903 these day begins with fresh breezes and cloudy weather at 9 a.m. saw school of black fish latter part the same so ends Lat 18.07 Long 41.23
