

June Thursday 11-1903 these day begins with fresh northeasterly winds and squally at 5 a.m. hoist on on the head got the junk in and cast bell the case and start the works at 2 p.m. cutting up the junk latter part the same so ends sin clair still lay up. Lat 31.02 Long 49.26

June Friday 12-1903 these day begins with light northeasterly winds and clear weather boiling at 8.30 a.m. raised a lone whale drop down two boats got fast at 12 noon came a longside pump out water and stored oil down the whale remainder a longside at 8.30 p.m. set the watch at the works so ends sin clair still up. Lat 31.08 Long 49.00

June Saturday 13-1903 these day begins with light northeasterly winds and clear weather pump out water and stored oil down at 9 a.m. got up the cutting gear and start cutting at 2 p.m. got head off and body in got the junk in and then the case bell start the works at 7 p.m. set the watch so ends sin clair still lay up

June Sunday 14-1903 these day begins with calm boiling pump water and stored oil down cut up junk latter part the same at the works so ends sin clair still lay up. Lat 30.15 Long 48.42

June Monday 15-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear boiling latter part fresh pump out water and stored oil down so ends sin clair still lay up. Lat 30.20 Long 49.28

June Tuesday 16-1903 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and cloudy stored oil down saw a sail and steamer latter part the same got true stored down at 5.30 p.m. sounds sin clair still lay up. Lat 30.38 Long 49.40

June Wednesday 17-1903 these day begins with fresh gale from west and rainy weather lay under two lower topsails at 12 noon raised shade whales from deck drop three boats but the whales heard the vessel and start to the windward at 2.30 p.m. the boats call on board latter part moderate some so ends sin clair still lay up

June Thursday 18-1903 these day begins with fresh S.W. winds and squally weather running steer N.E. at 9 a.m. raised a sail head went and spoke Joseph manta latter part the same so ends sin clair still lay up. Lat 31.17

June Friday 19-1903 these day begins with fresh S.W. and rainy weather latter part the same manta insight so ends sin clair still lay up

June Saturday 20-1903 these day begins with fresh S.W. and rainy weather latter part the same spoke manta under two lower topsails so ends sin clair still lay up
