

June Sunday 21-1903 these day begins with fresh SW. winds and rainy weather latter part moderate some the whole sail out manta in sight at 8 a.m. set short down sail so ends Lat 30.53 Long 49.39 sin clair still lay up

June Monday 22-1903 these day begins with light SW. winds and over cast running steer at 8.30 a.m. raised school of whales drop down in company with manta we got one manta two one small and one 50 barrel one got one small one from manta cut them in at 7.20 p.m. all hands got supper at 8 p.m. set the watches so ends

June Tuesday 23-1903 these day begins with fresh SW. winds and rainy weather clear the heads and start the words manta get the body in and head a large side latter part moderate some so ends Lat 31.12 Long 49.20 sin clair still lay up

June Wednesday 24-1903 these day begins with fresh SW. winds and squally weather boiling saw porpoises got true boiling at 3 p.m. latter part the same so ends Lat 31.15 Long 48.07

June Thursday 25-1903 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and rainy pump out water and stored the oil down that we got together with manta 4 cases 370-340-396-157.40 barrels latter part moderate some wind from E. so ends Lat 31.30 Long 48.13

Friday 26-1903 these day begins with light northerly winds and cloudy weather at noon begins with light rainy latter part the same at 4 p.m. short down sail so ends Lat 31.38 Long 49.00

Saturday 27-1903 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and over cast at 8 a.m. raised a large whale drop down three boats got past kill him and come a long side at 10 a.m. got up the cutting gear and got dinner at 12 noon start cutting at 5 p.m. got the head off and body in at 6 p.m. got supper and set the watches so ends Lat 31.09 Long 49.26

Sunday 28-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear weather at 4 a.m. got the junk in and bell the cable at 10 a.m. start the morses latter part cut up junk at 6 p.m. set the watches so ends Lat 31.06 Long 49.36

Monday 29-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and squally boiling and pump water and stored oil down latter part calm at 6 p.m. set the watches so ends Lat 30.48 Long 48.41

Tuesday 30-1903 these day begins with calm got true boiling at 1 p.m. pump water and stored oil down broke out shovels ready to set up cases latter part the same so ends Lat 30.42 Long 48.37
