Monday 20-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear weather. Steer NW. stored oil down at 8 a.m. raised a lone whale drop three boats got fast fair 11 Bombers lances at 2 p.m. came a large side stored the rest of the oil down got up the cutting gear ready to start cutting in the morning at 6.30 p.m. raised a rather whale from dead so end
Lat 32.17 Long 50.52

July

Tuesday 21-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear start cutting at 5 a.m. at 10.30 got the head off and body in at 11.30 got the gunde in last the cut the strip parrel cut up gunde and start the works latter part the same so end
Lat 32.30 Long 49.23

July

Wednesday 22-1903 these day begins with fresh & easterly winds and cloudy boiling one whaling schr in sight pump out water and stored down oil latter part the same at the works so end
Lat 32.20 Long 51.23

July

Thursday 23-1903 these day begins with fresh easterly winds and clear weather got boiling at 10.30 a.m. pump out water ready to stored oil down at 1.30 p.m. speak cannell latter part the same give cannell a coil of rope 2 1/4 inch one spare so end
Lat 32.25 Long 51.26

Friday 24-1903 these day begins with light easterly winds and clear weather cannell in sight running steer N. stored oil down got true at 2 p.m. latter part the same got up some shacks to set up at sun set short down sail so end
Lat 33.20 Long 51.15

Saturday 25-1903 these day begins with light SW. winds and clear weather running steer NW. latter part at 3 p.m. steer by the winds one schr and a bark in sight cut up a fluke chain and make a head strip set up 5 casks and start flaying so end
Lat 34.00 Long 51.35

Sunday 26-1903 these day begins with light SW. winds and clear weather the whale sail out heading S.E. one schooner in sight at 9.30 a.m. raised school of small whales drop those boats got fast one boat stove S.B. come a large side at 5 p.m. to late to cutting so end
Lat 33.14

Monday 27-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and heavy swell cutting the whale at 5.30 a.m. at 7 got true one sail in sight boiling Bark greyhound latter part the same at the works so end
Lat 33.04 Long 49.21
