

Aug Wednesday 5-1903 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and clear weather got true boiling at 2 p.m. spoke goshawk manta with 500 barrels latter part moderate some wash off decks so ends
Lat 32.02 Long 48.57

Aug Thursday 6-1903 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and overcast stored oil down saw grampers latter part the same wash off decks so ends
Lat 32.28 Long 49.23

Aug Friday 7-1903 these day begins with calm and clear repair the fore stays and mizzen top mast stay sail saw a whale carcass latter part the same so ends Lat 32.25 Long 49.45

Aug Saturday 8-1903 these day begins with calm and clear spoke a steamer latter part the same saw grampers so ends

Aug Sunday 9-1903 these day begins with light air from southern and clear running steer N. latter part N. E. at sun set short down sail so ends Lat 32.25 Long 49.33

Aug Monday 10-1903 these day begins with light S.W. winds clear weather running steer NE. latter part E. at sun set tacking the light sails steer E so ends Lat 32.38 Long 48.47

Aug Tuesday 11-1903 these day begins with light northerly winds and clear weather saw grampers latter part the same steer by the wind heading NE. the whale sail out so ends
Lat 33.02 Long 47.25

Aug Wednesday 12-1903 these day begins with fine weather light westerly winds and clear running steer NE. latter part E.S.E. one whaling schooner in sight at sun set short down sail saw porpoise one steamship so ends
Lat 34.13 Long 46.16

Aug Thursday 13-1903 these day begins with light westerly winds clear weather running steer NE. at 10 a.m. saw a did whale and garpas at 12. steer SE. at 3.20 p.m. raised a large whale going to the wind words drop three boats but did not have any chance come on board at 5.30 p.m. got supper and short down sail so ends Lat 34.33 Long 44.47

Aug Friday 14-1903 these day begins with light NW. winds and clear weather the whale sail out heading to the SW. at noon wore ship heading NE. saw grampers at sun set short down to lower top sails so ends
Lat 34.00 Long 44.38

Aug Saturday 15-1903 these day begins with calm and clear weather saw grampers porpoise one steamer latter part light air from NW. steer E. NE. so ends
Lat 34.07 Long 44.17
