

Aug Sunday 16-1903 these day begins with light SW. winds and squally weather saw porpoises latter part clear running steer NE. the whole sail out at sun set short down lay to so ends Samuel Gilbert sick Sat 34.50 Long 43.47

Aug Monday 17-1903 these day begins with light winds from W. SW. running steer NE. the whole sail out latter part E. saw black fish porpoises Sat sun set short down two lower top sails so ends Samuel Gilbert sick Sat 35.07 Long 43.07

Aug Tuesday 18-1903 these day begins with fresh SW. winds and squally weather under short sail heading to the south latter part moderate some saw a log drop a boat and catch some fish so ends Samuel Gilbert sick Sat 34.54 Long 41.59

Aug Wednesday 19-1903 these day begins with light westerly winds squally under short sail steer by the wind latter part wind hudd to the NE. at sun set short down heading SE. mizen stay parted so ends Samuel Gilbert sick Sat 34.36 Long 41.25

Thursday 20-1903 these day begins with fresh easterly winds and squally under short sail three sails in sight at 9 a.m. raised a school of small whales to the windwards drop three boats and put to the windwards chase them untill 3 p.m. the boats came on board at 4 p.m. latter part the same so ends Samuel still lay up

Friday 21-1903 these day begins with fresh easterly gale and clear under two lower top sails one sail in sight latter part moderate some so ends Samuel sick Sat 34.23 Long 40.23

Saturday 22-1903 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and cloudy at 10.30 a.m. one Barque in sight with the flyg up we running down to her and the captain ask if we could spare any provisions and capt answer yes and she drop a boat and come a long sight captain could two barrels of beef 12 barrel of flour one sack of beans fore 40.00 Dollar 1 or 8 lbs. or pounds latter part the same saw porpoises at sun set short down so ends Samuel sick

Sunday 23-1903 these day begins with fine weather light westerly winds and clear weather running steer NE. latter part E. SE. at sun set short down over to under short sail so ends Sat 35.53 Long 39.31 Samuel still sick
