

Aug Monday 24-1903 these day begins with light westerly winds and clear weather saw grampers latter part winds S.W. running steer E. S.E. the whole sail out Samuel sick so ends Sat 36:14 Sun 48:42

Aug Tuesday 25-1903 these day begins with fresh S.W. winds and clear weather saw one steamer one sail saw grampers running steer E. by N. latter part the same Samuel sick so ends Sat 36:45 Sun 36:10

Aug Wednesday 26-1903 these day begins with fresh S.W. winds and thick weather and sail in sight running steer E. by N. latter part moderate same so ends Samuel sick Sat 38:05 Sun 33:37

Aug Thursday 27-1903 these day begins with light S.W. winds thick weather at noon made island of Flores at 5:30 p.m. drop about captain went on shore fine out the news and came on board before dark stand off under short sail and spout but did not make out what it was Samuel sick so ends

Aug Friday 28-1903 these day begins with light S.W. winds and thick weather made captain went on shore in Santa Cruz and got his wife some beef and potatoes at 12:00 noon came on board start to fazeal latter part the same steer S.E. so ends

Aug Saturday 29-1903 these day begins with light southerly weather clear the whole sail out made fazeal at day light at sun set lay under the land saw grampers so ends

Aug Sunday 30-1903 these day begins with light S.W. winds and thick weather saw grampers and porpoises ~~the~~ chuing off the island of fazeal latter part the same so ends

Aug Monday 31-1903 these day begins with fresh northern and rainy weather latter part moderate same under short sail lay under fazeal saw grampers so ends

Sept Tuesday 1-1903 these day begins with fine weather came in to anchor inside of brack water morrer under four chain at 6:30 p.m. so ends four Busch of recruits come on board

Sept Wednesday 2nd 1903. Wash the Vessel and prepare for Discharge The "Greyhound" arrive in port. Fine Weather. begin with Westerly Winds

Sept Thursday 3rd 1903. The Weather begin fine South West wind Took ashore to Boats for repair & Empty Cask An Station Brig arrive in Distress

Sept Friday 4th 1903 Fine Weather, strong northern winds, dry sails,

Sept Saturday 5th 1903. This day begins fine Weather with northern winds Break open 20 Casks filled & Coopered ready for Delivered - so ends.
