

Sept. Sunday 6th 1903. this day begins fine weather light South West winds one watch ashore so ends

Sept. Monday 7th 1903 this day begins with light winds from South West, fine weather, shipped into Lighter 7025 gallons of Sperm oil
 1 man went ashore to doctor so ends.

Sept. Tuesday 8th 1903. this day begins with fine weather light Southern winds Broke out 19 Casks of oil refill 4 Bong. so ends

Sept. Wed. 9th 1903 the weather was warm no winds. Broke out 3 Casks, put into lighter 8 Casks of oil and she lay along side all night so ends.

Sept. Thursday 10th 1903. fine weather E. Light winds. Put into Lighter 20 Casks of oil lay alongside all night not fully loaded. so ends.

Sept. Friday 11th 1903. put on Board the Bright Harry Smith 8313 gallons of oil finish loaded the lighter Mary Simmons arrive, Canton, arrive outside the Break water So ends

Sept. Saturday 12th 1903 the last of oil put into lighter and laid alongside all night. Canton brought to her Mornings so ends

Sept. Sunday 13th 1903. this day begins with light Southern winds fine weather one watch ashore so ends

Sept. Monday 14th 1903. this day begins with strong Southern winds brought 16 Casks from shore & made 5 Casks board ship, stow 8 Cask in the hold & the Sunbeam arrive & brought to her morning with 200 Barrels of oil so ends.

Sept. Tuesday 15th 1903. fine weather strong S.W. winds Making & Stowing casks receive 1 lighter of Provision "Morning Star" & "Elena Swift" arrive & moved

Sept. Wednesday 16th 1903. this day begins with plenty thick fog & light rain clear up in the noon making casks & stowing the vessel. a man of war anchor out side the Breakwater ~~so ends~~ receive some Provisions so ends.

Sept. Thursday 17th 1903. this day begins with light ENE winds fine weather prepare for making water so ends.

Sept. Friday 18th 1903 this day begins with light rain & heavy fog made 2 raft of water with Taint Boat so ends.

Sept. Saturday 19th 1903. this day begins with Rain heavy in the morning, in the Afternoon it clear up a little made 1 raft of water receive 1 basket of fruit strike down the fore & main gallant yards so ends.

Sept. Sunday 20th 1903 fine weather strong NE winds 1 watch went ashore so ends.
