

Dec Friday 18-1903 these day begins with fresh gale from southern steer by the wind under short sail latter part moderate same so ends Lat 28.30 S+ Long 08.43 W.

Dec Saturday 19-1903 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and squally steer by the wind under short sail latter part light the whole sail out so ends Lat 27.57 S+

Dec Sunday 20-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear steer by the winds the whole sail out latter part the same so ends Lat 27.30 Long 06.10 W.

Dec Monday 21-1903 these day begins with light air and squally heading various way to the W. and to the east latter part the same so ends Lat 27.03 S.

Dec Tuesday 22-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear weather steer by the wind heading to the southern latter part the same so ends Lat 27.36 S+ Long 05.16 W.

Dec Wednesday 23-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and cloudy steer by the wind heading to the southwards latter part the same so ends Lat 27.56 S+

Thursday 24-1903 these day begins with fresh southeasterly winds and cloudy weather steer by the winds heading to the southern and west under short sail latter part the same so ends Lat 29.32 S+ Long 06.20 W.

Friday 25-1903 these day begins with fresh southeasterly winds and squally weather under short sail steer by the wind heading to the southwards latter part the same so ends

Saturday 26-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and cloudy steer by the wind heading S.W. the whole sail out saw gumpers latter part the same so ends Lat 32.20 S+ Long 07.06 W.

Sunday 27-1903 these day begins with light air from southern and clear steer E. by S. the whole sail out latter part the same so ends Lat 32.58 S+ Long 06.54 W.

Monday 28-1903 these day begins with light air from west and foggy weather latter part clear up some steer E. by S. to broil out beef and bread last on the case so ends Lat 32.37 S+ Long 05.51 W.

Tuesday 29-1903 these day begins with light southerly winds and foggy weather latter part the same so ends Lat 32.11 S+
