

Dec wednesday 30-1903 these day begins with calm and foggy latter part light air from NW. steer E. the whale sail out so ends Lat 31.42 S. Long 03.37 W.

Dec Thursday 31-1903 these day begins with light Northwesterly winds and clear weather running steer E. the whale sail out latter part the same so ends Lat 31.10 S. Long 01.59 W.

Jan Friday 1-1904 these day begins with light northerly winds and clear weather steer by the wind heading E. by N. the whale sail out latter part fresh up same so ends Lat 30.02 S. Long 00.31 E.

Jan Saturday 2-1904 these day begins with light westerly winds and squally weather running steer E. by N. the whale sail out latter part fresh and clear up till a hog saw porpoises so ends Lat 28.25 S. Long 02.47 E.

Jan Sunday 3-1904 these day begins with fresh south east winds and cloudy weather steer E. by N. latter part E. N. under topsails and courses so ends Lat 26.15 S. Long 05.09 E.

Jan Monday 4-1904 these day begins with fresh gale from the south under tow lower topsails and fore sail latter part the same so ends

Tuesday 5-1904 these day begins with fresh southerly gale and heavy swell on running steer E. NE. latter part moderate some under short sail so ends Lat 23.05 S. Long 08.08 E.

wednesday 6-1904 these day begins with light southerly winds and overcast running steer E. NE. under the whale sail latter part the same saw a steamer and cal fish at sun set short down sail so ends Lat 20.55 S. Long 09.08 E.

Thursday 7-1904 these day begins with light breezes and thick weather running steer E. NE. latter part clear up the whale sail out saw a fin barge at sun set short down sail saw lower topsails so ends Lat 19.25 S. Long 10.11 E.

Friday 8-1904 these day begins with calm and over cast latter part clear up and light air saw a school of black fish so ends Lat 18.50 S. Long 10.44 E.

Saturday 9-1904 these day begins with calm and clear weather latter part light breezes and clear steer E. under the whale sail so ends Lat 18.30 S. Long 11.03 E.

Sunday 10-1904 these day begins with light breezes and clear weather the whale sail out steer by the wind made cape frie at 7 a.m. stormer off. the whale day saw a fin barge latter part the same at sun set short down sail so ends Lat 18.07 S. Long 10.50 E.
