

Jan Monday 11-1904 these day begins with light breads and clear weather running steer N.W. the whale sail out saw killers and fin barrels porpoises latter part the same so ends
Lat 17.40 Long 09.32 E.

Jan Tuesday 12-1904 these day begins with light breads and overcast running steer N.E. latter part by the wind heading in to the eastwards at sun set short down so ends Lat 16.110 S+ Long 09.415 E.

Jan Wednesday 13-1904 these day begins with fresh breads and overcast heading S.E. under short sail saw a fin barrel latter part heavy breads at sun set set worship and short down sail so ends

Jan Thursday 14-1904 these day begins with heavy breads and overcast under tow lower top sails latter part the same so ends

Jan Friday 15-1904 these day begins with light breads and cloudy weather latter part the same saw porpoises at sun set short down sail broke out water and beef. new cattle so ends
Lat 15.50 S+ Long 10.35 E.

Jan Saturday 16-1904 these day begins with calm and clear weather and whaling Barge in sight suppose to be the sunbeam latter part light air from the west heading to the southern so ends
Lat 15.45 S+ Long 10.33 E.

Sunday 17-1904 these day begins with light westerly winds and clear weather sunbeam in sight at 4 p.m. raised school of small whales sunbeam drop 4 boats and we drop three S.B. went on dorking but did not get iron down out sunbeam boat got one come on board at 7 p.m. so ends
Lat 16.05 S+ Long 10.49 E.

Monday 18-1904 these day begins with calm and cloudy latter part clear tow sail in sight tow barrels saw porpoises so ends
Lat 16.02 Long 10.09 E.

Tuesday 19-1904 these day begins with light air and clear weather saw fin barrel and porpoises latter part the same tow whaling barrels in sight so ends Lat 16.12 S+ Long 09.49 E.

Wednesday 20-1904 these day begins with calm and clear weather saw killers and porpoises middle part light air under the whale sail latter part good breeze at sun set short down sail so ends Lat 16.06 S+ Long 10.06 E.

Thursday 21-1904 these day begins with light winds and cloudy saw fin barrels and porpoises for the whale day at 7.30 a.m. saw a barrel cutting latter part the same at sun set short down sail tow lower top sails so ends
Lat 16.07 S+ Long 10.40 E.
