

- May Sunday 8-1904 these day begins with fine weather latter part the same so ends
- May Monday 9-1904 these day begins with fine weather send tow barrels on shore one flour one beef at 5 p.m. sail the whole sail out steer N.W. tow Schooners sail the same time so ends
- May Tuesday 10-1904 these day begins with light breezes and cloudy weather the whole sail out steer by the wind made Sanbweiro at day light latter part the same brock out bread and fell one tub of whale to line so ends
- May Wednesday 11-1904 these day begins with light breezes and cloudy weather steer by the wind the whole sail out latter part the same brock out beef one barrels so ends

- May Thursday 12-1904 these day begins with light breezes and cloudy weather bend new main top gallant sail latter part the same so ends
- May Friday 13-1904 these day begins with light southerly winds and squally weather latter part streed run steer by the wind heading E. wind from N. under short sail so ends

- May Saturday 14-1904 these day begins with light Northerly winds and clear weather steer by the wind heading E and E.NE. latter part the same rove new main braces made new cover for the potato pine so ends

- May Tuesday 17-1904 these day begins with light easterly winds and clear weather steer by the wind the whole sail out latter part the same roved new main gallant yard braces so ends
