

May Friday 20-1904 these day begins with light southerly winds and clear weather steer E.N.E. the whale sail out repair main up to sail later part the same so ends Lat 28.24 Long 59.46
third mate off duty cause by sicking

May Saturday 21-1904 these day begins with light southerly winds and cloudy sky by the wind the whale sail out one sail in sight later part the same so ends Lat 29.32 Long 58.21

May Sunday 22-1904 these day begins with light southerly winds and thide weather steer by the wind the whale sail out heading E. later part the same so ends mr. Lopes off duty by sicking Lat 30.05 Long 56.19

May Monday 23-1904 these day begins with fresh southerly winds and cloudy steer E.N.E. under short sail latter part the same broke out water at sun set short down low bows to sail so ends Lat 30.50 Long 55.01

May Tuesday 24-1904 these day begins with light southerly winds and thide weather steer E. the whale sail out saw school of black fish latter part the same so ends mr. Lopes sick off duty Lat 31.12 Long 53.46

May Wednesday 25-1904 these day begins with light westerly winds and cloudy running steer E. latter part the same mr. Lopes still sick so ends Lat 31.15 Long 52.53

May Thursday 26-1904 these day begins with light northerly winds and cloudy weather saw a spair and a brichau but did not see any thing more at sun set short down track lost of fish saends mr. Lopes still sick Lat 31.05 Long 52.08

May Friday 27-1904 these day begins with light air from easterly and clear steer by the wind heading to the northern latter part the same at sun set short down so ends mr. Lopes still sick Lat 31.77 Long 52.06

May Saturday 28-1904 these day begins with light air from southern the whale sail out steer by the wind heading E. at 2.30 p.m. raised school of small whales drop down three boats got fast got 11 whales came a long side at 6 p.m. got super set the watch so ends

May Sunday 29-1904 these day begins with calm start cutting at 5.30 a.m. at 10.20 got true at noon start the morder at work boiling oil the watches at 6 p.m. so end mr. Lopes tune to work still no will
