June Wednesday 1-1904 these day begins with light air from east cutting the whale at 6.45 get true stored oil down start the works at 11 a.m. later part the same saw grampers at work so ends

June Thursday 2-1904 these day begins with light northerly winds and clear weather got true boiling at 4 a.m. later part the same at sun set short down sail. spr. Sops. time to so ends
 Sat 30.58 Long 50.51

June Friday 3-1904 these day begins with fresh easterly winds and clear weather heading to the north the whale sail out later part moderate some at sun set short down sail stored the oil down so ends
 Sat 31.18 Long 50.28

June Saturday 4-1904 these day begins with calm and clear later part the same so ends

June Sunday 5-1904 these day begins with light westerly winds and clear weather the whale sail out at 8 a.m. raised a large whale long ways off. tow points on weath bow did not see him again later part the same at sun set short down so ends

June Monday 6-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and squally weather saw hills and grampers latter part clear at sun set short down so ends
 Sat 30.58 Long 50.29

June Tuesday 7-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and clear weather running steer E.N.E. later part the same saw grampers at sun set short down so ends
 Sat 31.16 Long 49.42

June Wednesday 8-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and thick weather saw grampers under short sail later part moderate some at sun set ~~at~~ tacking the fore sail so ends
 Sat 32.05 Long 49.24

June Thursday 9-1904 these day begins with light northwesterly winds and clear at 5 a.m. raised school of large bulls whales deep three boats tow get fast came a long side at 12 noon
